## General Information

**1. What action are you requesting from the Board?** Approval of an IGA with the Oregon Department of Transportation for improvements to East County Traffic Signal System, intercommunications and Intelligent Transportation System (ITS).

**2. Please provide sufficient background information for the Board and the public to understand this issue. Please note which Program Offer this action affects and how it impacts the results.** This project will provide various upgrades to current technology for the existing Traffic Signal network in the East Metro Area (East County). Improvements include upgraded signal controllers, fiber optic network connections between signals and installation of on demand advance notice signage for traffic, that will provide advance warning of approaching traffic issues (ITS). This project is multi-jurisdictional but predominantly impacts the City of Gresham. The County still has several intersections with Traffic Signals and controllers, but through an Intergovernmental agreement with the City of Gresham, the County's signal system is maintained by Gresham. As a result, County Engineering Staff will work in concert with the City in conducting these improvements, but the design and installation will be performed by City of Gresham and their contractor. The end result of this work will be a more coordinated regional traffic flow for East County, with ability for remote adjustments based on traffic demand.

**3. Explain the fiscal impact (current year and ongoing).** This is a grant funded project and the County share is expected to be limited to \$10,000. Budgeted Road Fund is sufficient to absorb this cost.

**4. Explain any legal and/or policy issues involved.** None

**5. Explain any citizen and/or other government participation that has or will take place.** City anticipates appropriate public notice, prior to construction activity. County Information office will augment that communication effort.
