Adoption of the proclamation naming August 22nd through August 31st, 2014, as Civil Rights Week in Multnomah County, Oregon.

The March on Washington for Jobs and Freedom took place in Washington, D.C., on August 28, 1963. Attended by some 250,000 people, it was the largest demonstration ever seen in the nation's capital, and one of the first to have extensive television coverage.

This proclamation commemorates the 50th Anniversary of this event. Speakers will share historical perspectives, but also discuss ways in which community members can continue to strive for equity and justice.
