ORDINANCE NO. 80

An Ordinance harmonizing the Public Safety Retirement Ordinance with the Civil Service Rules and Regulations for hiring Deputy Sheriffs; amending Multnomah County Ordinance No. 53, Article I, Section 1 (17).

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 53, Article I, Section 1 (17), is amended to read as follows:

(17) "Sworn Law Enforcement Officer" means an employee of Multnomah County assigned to the Department of Public Safety who is required to render service as such to the County not less than thirty-five (35) hours per week, exclusive of vacation, sick leave and bona fide leave of absence, and who also holds a position in one of the following job classifications under the classified civil service system of Multnomah County:

- (a) Captain
- (b) Lieutenant
- (c) Sergeant/Detective
- (d) Identification Technician
- (e) Deputy Sheriff (Patrolman)

excepting, however, a person who entered County service at any time after the day preceding his thirty-third birthday after June 30, 1969.

Section 2. This amendment is retroactive to and including June 30, 1969.

Section 3. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
