You would need 6 copies if you submit paper copies at the Hearing.

The amount of time will depend on the number of folks who sign up to testify. At budget hearings, it is typically 2 minutes per person.

It is at the Chair's discretion.

If you cannot attend, you can most certainly submit your testimony in advance. We circulate it to the Commissioners and their Staff.

I've attached the form for ease of access. Please note that your testimony sheet is a public record. Address, etc. are optional. If you have any questions about the form itself, or filling it out, please let me know. I am happy to help.
