ORDER

93-319

WHEREAS, On December 29, 1992 the Board of County Commissioners amended the County Comprehensive Framework Plan to include Bridal Veil in the inventory of significant historic resources pursuant to the statewide planning Goal 5 process; and

WHEREAS, On May 17, 1993 the Planning Commission approved a Resolution to adopt a Goal 5 inventory and Task Force recommendations that provided a protection program for Bridal Veil pursuant to the Goal 5 process; and

WHEREAS, Bridal Veil is located within the Columbia River Gorge National Scenic Area. In January, 1993 Multnomah County adopted ordinances to comply with requirements of the Scenic Area Management Plan. On August 9, 1993 final concurrence of compliance with the Management Plan was received; and


WHEREAS, Statewide Planning Goals do not apply within the National Scenic Area, so any decision on this matter would not apply to future land use decisions for which application could be made under the new ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 96 precludes the Land Use Board of Appeals from reviewing land use decisions in the National Scenic Area for compliance with statewide planning goals, so any decision in this matter would not be appealable.


NOW, THEREFORE in light of the effect of Senate Bill 96 and federal approval of the county's National Scenic Area ordinance which makes statewide planning goals inapplicable, the Board of Commissioners, in accordance with MCC 11.05.250, rejects the recommendation of the Planning Commission and takes no further action on this matter.
