WHEREAS, Multnomah County supports the goal of ensuring that no otherwise qualified individual with a disability shall, solely on the basis of the disability, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program, service or activity offered by the County or its subrecipients, as mandated by the Department of Justice regulations contained in 28 CFR Part 35; and

WHEREAS, Multnomah County supports the employment goal of ensuring that no qualified individual with a disability shall, solely on the basis of the disability, be subject to discrimination in employment under any program, service or activity provided by Multnomah County as mandated by the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission regulations contained in 29 CFR Part 1630.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners reaffirms its intent to comply with the provisions of 28 CFR Part 35 and 29 CFR Part 1630.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners designates the City/County Affirmative Action Office, to coordinate and implement its efforts to comply with Rules and Regulations set forth as a result of the 1990 Americans with Disabilities Act including programs, services, and activities and employment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners reaffirms its support for policies that are designed to prohibit discrimination on the basis of disability.
