PROCLAMATION
92-201

WHEREAS, The Health and Safety Committee of the Portland/Multnomah Commission on Aging has identified elder abuse and public safety as a priority concern of the elderly; and

WHEREAS, the Portland/Multnomah Commission on Aging in cooperation with other community groups and corporations applied for and received a federal grant to fund the Elder Safety Coalition whose purpose is to develop partnerships with public and private interests in addressing safety issues for senior living in N/NE Portland area; and
