

1 BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
2 FOR MULTNOMAH COUNTY, OREGON
3 ORDINANCE NO. 759

5 An ordinance transferring jurisdiction over Way of Necessity
6 Proceedings to the Multnomah County Circuit Court.

7 Multnomah County Ordains as follows:

8 Section I. Findings:

9 A. ORS 376.200 provides that a county governing body may
10 adopt an ordinance removing the governing body from jurisdiction of
11 the statutory establishment of Ways of Necessity, whereupon the
12 Circuit Court would assume jurisdiction.

13 B. Ways of Necessity proceedings require the Board to sit in
14 a judicial capacity concerning matters which would be more
15 appropriately addressed by the Circuit Court.

16 C. The interests of the owners of property and the residents
17 of Multnomah County would be better served if the Circuit Court
18 assumed jurisdiction over statutory establishment of Ways of
19 Necessity within Multnomah County.

20 Section II. Action:

21 The Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County, Oregon
22 is hereby removed from jurisdiction of the statutory establishment
23 of Ways of Necessity. Pursuant to ORS 376.200, the Circuit Court
24 of Multnomah County, Oregon shall have jurisdiction of the
25 statutory establishment of Ways of Necessity.



5 5.50 of the Charter of Multnomah County, Oregon.


