Commissioner Shiprack's FY15 Budget Note

- Follow up on trip to Bexar County
- \$100,000 for LPSCC to facilitate process and convene stakeholders to produce assessment
 - Evaluate current jail diversion programs
 - Estimate number of people in Multnomah County in need of mental health diversion services
 - Evaluate community capacity to sustain new programming
 - Estimate savings

Assessment process

- Selection of Lore Joplin
- Ongoing consultation with Commissioner Shiprack
- Align with other mental health public safety system improvement efforts
- Budget Modification: December 4, 2014
