ORDINANCE NO. 231

An ordinance amending the Personnel Ordinance of Multnomah County to provide a right of appeal from personnel actions, including complaints of discrimination by employees of and applicants for the classified service; providing retroactivity and declaring an emergency.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. The following is added as MCC 3.10.025:

In addition to any appeal right granted elsewhere in this chapter, there shall be a right of appeal by any employee of and applicants for the classified service regarding personnel actions including complaints of discrimination, directly to the Council in the manner prescribed by MCC 3.10.300(C).


Section 2. This amendment shall apply to all employees of and applicants for the classified service aggrieved by any personnel action, or who may have a complaint of discrimination, occurring prior to the effective date hereof.

Section 3. This ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the rights and interests of persons in the classified service of the County, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.




