Ordinance No. 343

An Ordinance fixing the county salary supplement of the District Attorney of Multnomah County and referring the matter to the November 2, 1982, general election.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. The county supplement to the salary of the Multnomah County District Attorney is set in the amount of \$11,032.


SECTION 2. This ordinance is referred to the electors of Multnomah County and it is in the public interest that the matter be voted upon at the November 2, 1982, general election. Attached Exhibit A is the ballot title to be used at that election.

SECTION 3. If approved by the electors of Multnomah County, this Ordinance will take effect January 1, 1983.



EXHIBIT A

BALLOT TITLE

Caption: Fixes County Salary of Multnomah County District Attorney

Question: Shall the county salary supplement of the Multnomah County District Attorney be fixed in the annual amount of \$11,032?

Explanation: The District Attorney of Multnomah County is a state official elected and serving in Multnomah County. Oregon law allows the county to supplement his/her salary with county funds. This measure, if approved, would set that annual county salary supplement in the amount of \$11,032. The District Attorney's current annual state salary is \$42,348.
