General Information

1. What action are you requesting from the Board?

We are requesting approval of the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) for the NW Cornelius Pass Rd: US 30 – NW Kaiser Rd Agreement. This is a new IGA which replaces the previous one (#28604).

2. Please provide sufficient background information for the Board and the public to understand this issue. Please note which Program Offer(s) this action affects and how it impacts the results.

This project was planned to be managed by County's staff but contracted by ODOT procurement's office. However, since County is in final stage of the "test" phase in "Certification Program", and that the preliminary engineering phase is almost complete, Multnomah County Transportation and ODOT agreed to deliver the rest of the Project (construction procurement and administration phase) as a certified project. This means County and ODOT need to enter in an IGA to address this change in delivery method. Certification means County will procure and administer the construction contract and activities.

3. Explain the fiscal impact (current year and ongoing).

Project is fully funded by federal grant and state funds. No change in the funding of this project.
