Approving a Sole Source Procurement Process for Existing Disaster Recovery Data Center Co-Location Lease and Services

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. The Board, acting as the Multnomah County Public Contract Review Board (PCRB) and pursuant to PCRB Rule 47-0275, must approve sole source procurements for Services Contracts of \$150,000 or more.
- b. The County contracts with ViaWest, Inc., a Colorado corporation, to lease and provide related services for the County's disaster recovery data center co-location.
- c. The County has contracted with ViaWest since 2011. Extending the ViaWest relationship allows the County to maintain this resource, effectively manage its costs, and to develop specifications over a reasonable time period for establishing a new disaster recovery data center at a location outside of the Cascadia Subduction Zone.
- d. Procurement authority allowing the County to contract with ViaWest expires October 30, 2016.
- e. This sole source approval extends procurement authority to contract with ViaWest until September 30, 2019, which corresponds to the timeframe needed to develop new specifications and standup a new disaster recovery data center located outside of the Cascadia Subduction Zone.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:

To approve a sole source procurement authorizing the County to contract with ViaWest from September 30, 2016, to September 29, 2019, for an estimated \$914,040.00.
