ORDER  
No. 90-191

WHEREAS, the safety and welfare of the general public may be protected by restricting the length of vehicles operating on certain County roads; and

WHEREAS, limits on the weight and dimension of vehicles or combination of vehicles may be imposed by order of county governing bodies under ORS 810.030; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution dated April 16, 1981, the Board of County Commissioners ordered limits on the total length of certain vehicle combinations on certain roads in Multnomah County, including portions of NE 238th Dr and NE 242nd Dr.; and

WHEREAS, The Board desires to establish vehicle length limitations on certain county roads herein described, including portions of roads affected by the 1981 Resolution.

NOW THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR MULTNOMAH COUNTY ORDERS:

1. The length of any vehicle or combination of vehicles, including load, operating on the following roads is restricted to a maximum of 40 feet without a special permit:

- A. NE 238th Dr. (I-84 to Glisan St.)
- B. NE & SE 242nd Dr. (Glisan St. to Stark St.)
- C. NE Buxton St. (Columbia Hwy. to Cherry Park Rd.)
- D. NE & SE Troutdale Rd. (Cherry Park Rd. to Stark St.)

2. The restrictions set forth above shall replace any restrictions set forth in the Resolution dated April 16, 1981, entitled "In the Matter of Approval of Excess Vehicle Length for Designated County Arterials" for the portions of county roads above described.
