General Information

1. What are you requesting from the Board?

Informational briefing regarding the Sheriff's Office Food Services Contract #44-2612 with Aramark to provide meals to inmates in our jails.

2. Please provide sufficient background information for the Board and the public to understand this issue. Please note which Program Offer(s) this action affects and how it impacts the results.

Inmate meals are a critical component of the care and custody of inmates in our jails. The meals are regulated by state statutes and all meals must meet specified nutritional requirements. There are different dietary requirements including medical diets, religious diets and enhanced meals. Inmate workers are involved in food preparation, and receive training in food services. Sustainability and local sourcing are an important part of our food services program.

3. Explain the fiscal impact (current year and ongoing).

\$20 million over the next 5 fiscal years (FY2016 – FY2021)

4. Explain any legal and/or policy issues involved.

Corrections meals for inmates have requirements in Oregon State Statute and also in the Oregon Jail Standards.

5. Explain any citizen and/or other government participation that has or will take place.

The Board of County Commissioners, Corrections Grand Jury and the CBAC have all sampled Jail meals as part of their oversight responsibilities. Every year the Oregon State Sheriff's Association Jail Command Council conducts an audit of the jail's operations. Multnomah County Health Officer s conducts a health and sanitation inspection of the jail's kitchens twice a year.
