

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR  
MULTNOMAH COUNTY, OREGON  
ORDINANCE NO. 108

An Ordinance relating to fees and amending Ordinance No. 100,  
and declaring an emergency.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. The following section is added to and made a part of  
Ordinance No. 100:

The provisions of Sections 8.30 to 8.38 of this Ordinance, or  
any other provisions of this ordinance now or subsequently in effect  
which relate to procedures for amendment hereof, shall not apply to  
changes or amendments which relate to fees prescribed in Title 13 of  
this ordinance or to any other fees established in connection with  
matters subject to this ordinance. The establishment of any such fees,  
and amendments thereof, shall be prescribed by the Board of County  
Commissioners of Multnomah County, Oregon, acting in accordance with  
Chapter V of the Charter of Multnomah County.

Section 2. Section 13.03(a) of Ordinance No. 100 is amended to  
read:

(a) Temporary Permits	\$60.00
	(\$30.00 renewal)

Section 3. The following Section 13.05 is added to and made a  
part of Ordinance No. 100:

In the case of any hearing required under this ordinance which  
must be rescheduled at the request of or due to the neglect of the  
applicant, a fee of \$100.00 shall be assessed against the applicant.

Said fee may be waived in whole or in part by the Director of Planning and Development if he determines that the necessity for the requested rescheduling was unavoidable or that the applicant proceeded with all possible diligence to give adequate advance notice of the request for rescheduling.

Section 4. Adoption.

This ordinance, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the people of Multnomah County, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption, pursuant to Section 5.50 of the Charter of Multnomah County.

ADOPTED this 12th day of August, 1975, being the date of its first reading before the Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County, Oregon.
