PROCLAMATION NO. 08-034

Proclaiming April 2008 as National Sexual Assault Awareness Month in Multnomah County, Oregon and acknowledging the important contribution of the Sexual Assault Nurse Examiners (SANEs) of Oregon Health Sciences University

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. Sexual violence is a devastating and intolerable crime, affecting men, women, and children of all ages, races, sexual orientation, cultures and economic situations and abilities.
- b. Sexual assaults in the United States are at a disturbingly high level. 1 in 6 women, and 1 in 33 men, have been victims of sexual assault.¹ It is estimated that only one in 8 sexual assaults are reported to law enforcement.²
- c. The Multnomah County Sexual Assault Response Team (SART) is a multi-agency group dedicated to continuously improve our community response to sexual assault.
- d. The Sexual Assault Nurse Examiners (SANEs) at the Oregon Health Sciences University (OHSU) over the years have consistently provided compassionate and professional support to victims of sexual assault.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Proclaims:

1. Our deepest gratitude and thanks to the SANEs at OHSU.
2. The Month of April 2008 is proclaimed to be National Sexual Assault Awareness Month in Multnomah County, Oregon.
