Chair Linn, Board Members to Co-Host Review of School-Based Support Programs

Multnomah County Chair Diane Linn and members of the Board of County Commissioners will co-host with county school district superintendents a review of the county's program that links a range of after-school, anti-poverty and other services for youth and their families and delivers them in schools and other neighborhood sites.

The meeting will take place on **Friday, June 4** from ^{9:30} ~~4~~ **am to 11am** at the **Multnomah Educational Service District** offices, located at **11611 NE Ainsworth Circle in Portland**. The event is open to the public and the media.

The programs, known collectively as the School-Age Policy Framework, combine various efforts by the City of Portland, Multnomah County and non-profit providers targeted toward at-risk youth and their families. **The program includes nationally-acclaimed Schools Uniting Neighborhoods (SUN) schools, which now total 46 in the county. Other services include mental health care, immunization checks and emergency housing assistance.**

The review comes as the Board of County Commissioners moves toward completing its budget for the fiscal year that begins July 1. The Board is scheduled to adopt a final budget on June 10.

"This program is one of my top priorities and has broad support across the county," Linn said. "I look forward to hearing how these school-based services are helping our kids and our schools."

Among the issues Linn said she hopes to pursue at the meeting is the impact of the school-based services on helping reduce gang involvement and other crime, and whether all portions of the county are receiving an equitable share of the services.

Linn has pledged to hold or participate in hearings and take other steps to increase public participation in important policy matters. Another hearing planned for this summer will look at ways to utilize the Wapato jail facility.

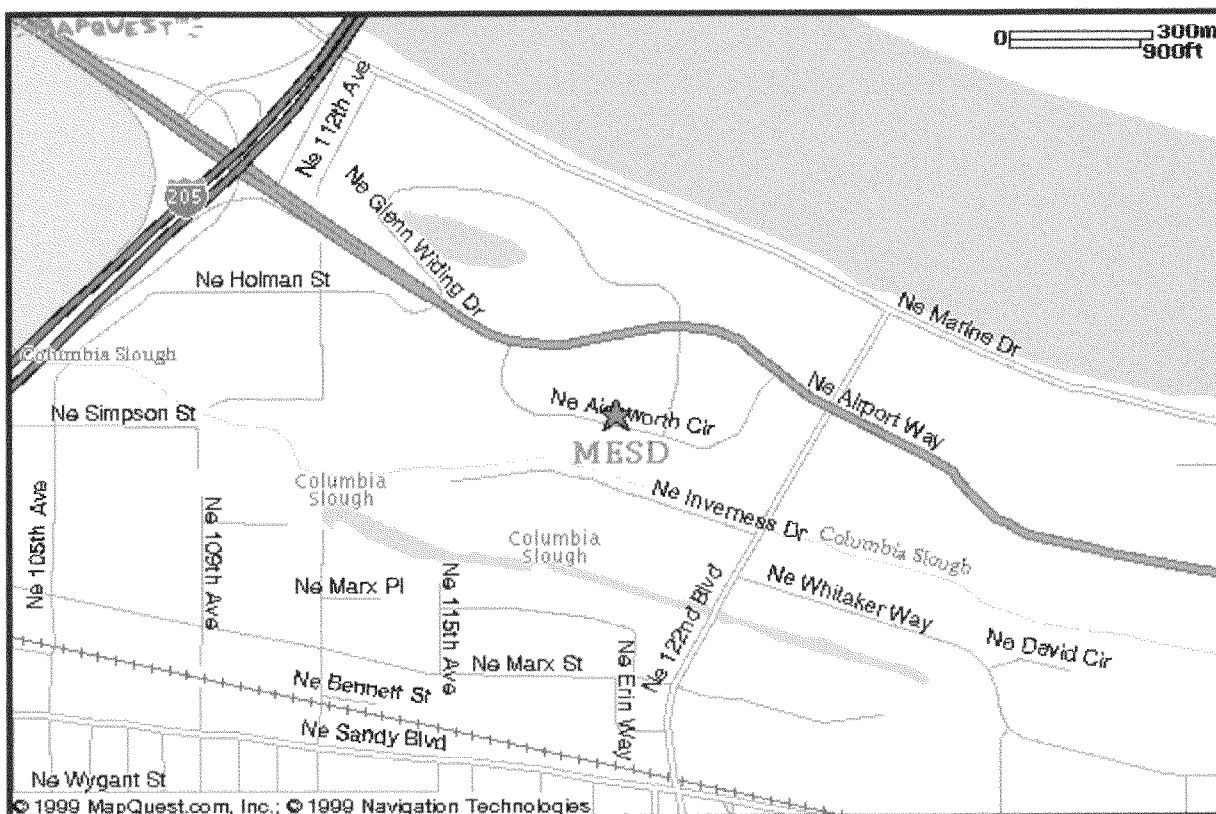

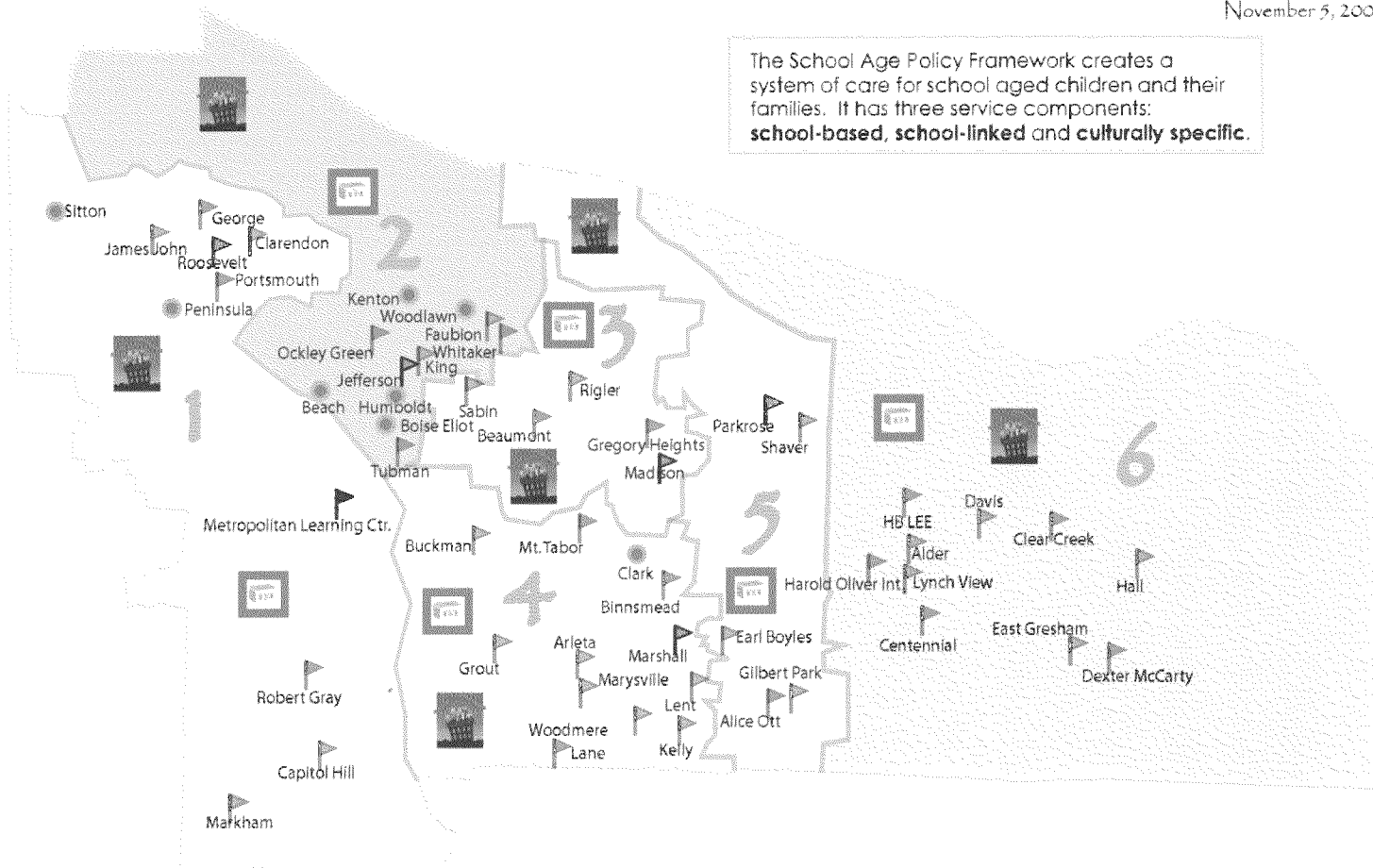

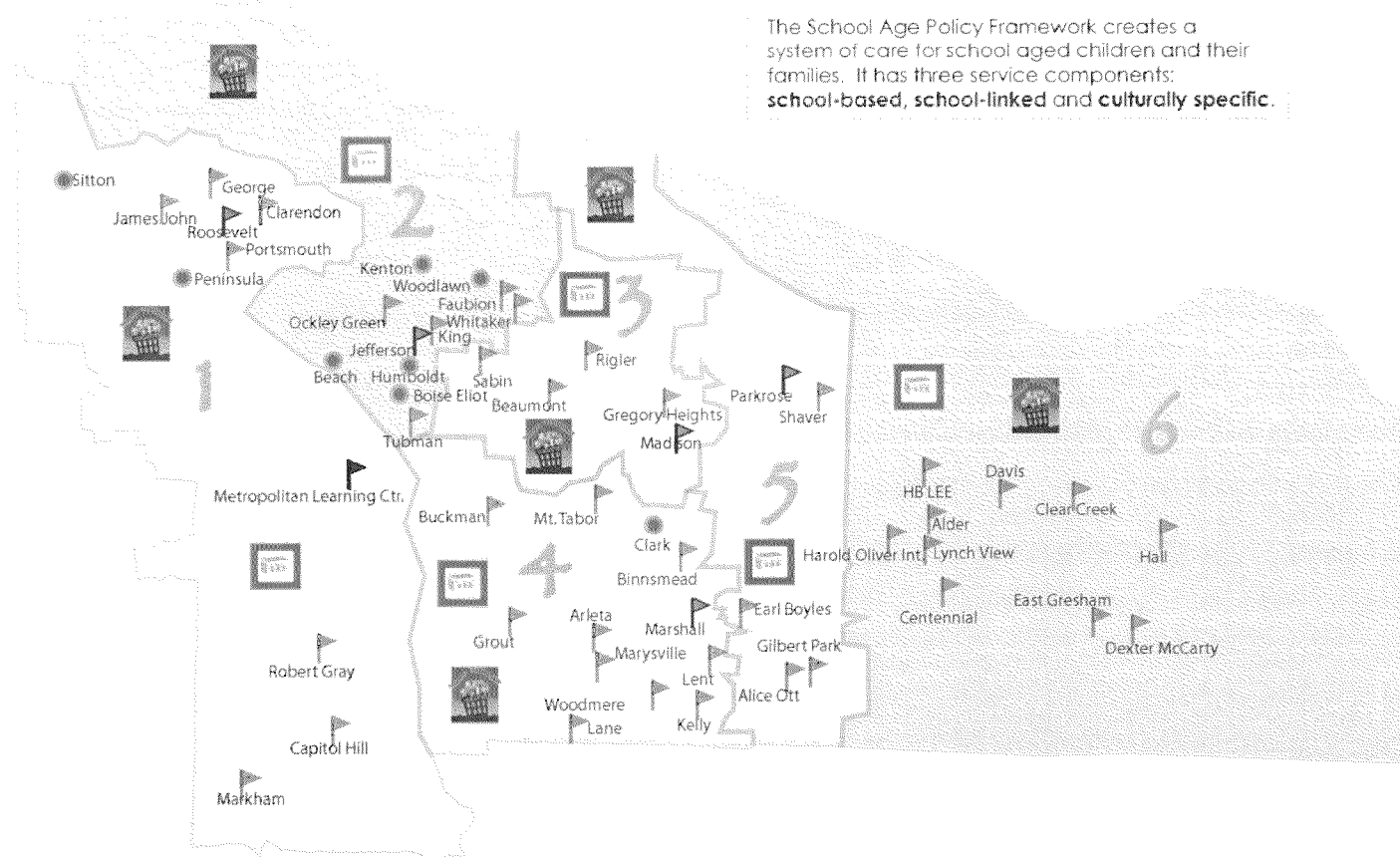
