



Addendum to:

Multnomah County's Letter of Intent to Participate in Justice Reinvestment
Grant Program
August 26, 2013.

Multnomah County's Local Public Safety Coordinating Council (LPSCC) appointed a workgroup to develop consensus around system improvements and use of Justice Reinvestment funds. This workgroup has developed a system change that will improve the information available to criminal justice system partners to develop the most effective resolution for the individual felony cases.

This proposed change integrates a process to provide timely, neutral and consistent risk/needs assessment for felony offenders early on in a case processing. This assessment component will inform the sentencing process to achieve the best outcomes matching the right level of supervision and sanctions to the individual offenders and result in a more timely resolution of the case. This system change will allow us to optimize the use of our community-based sanctions, services and programs designed to improve public safety by helping offenders achieve success in the community while reducing the impact of our County's use of state prison beds. A copy of the work group's April 2, 2013 report to LPSCC Executive Committee is attached.
