Informational Briefing on Transportation Division Capital Projects. No Board action required.

The Community Services Transportation Division maintains and improves approximately 270 miles of roads, 6 Willamette River Bridges, and over 20 smaller structures. Capital projects are those maintenance and improvement projects that require significant design and management and require outside construction contractors to complete (instead of being performed by County maintenance forces).

Transportation Capital projects are generally funded from a combination of County Road or Bridge funds and funding from sources outside the County, such as Federal Highway Administration, Oregon Department of Transportation, and Metro.
