Approving a Sole Source Procurement Process for Existing Practice Management and Electronic Health Record Technology

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. The Board, acting as the Multnomah County Public Contract Review Board (PCRB) and pursuant to PCRB Rule 47-0275, must approve sole-source procurements for Services Contracts of \$150,000 or more.
- b. The County contracts with the Oregon Community Health Information Network (OCHIN, Inc.) for information systems and system support specifically surrounding the customized implementation of the Epic Practice Management system and Electronic Health Records (EHR).
- c. The County has contracted with OCHIN since 1999. The OCHIN collaboration allows customization specific to County needs. Leaving the collaborative would require significant time and cost to implement a new system.
- d. Procurement authority allowing the County to contract with OCHIN expires June 30, 2016.
- e. This sole source approval extends procurement authority to contract with OCHIN until June 30, 2018.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:

To approve a sole source procurement authorizing the County to contract with OCHIN from July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2018, for an estimated \$4,500,000.00.
