Ordinance 1183 created the Multnomah County Business Advisory Council ("BAC") to help improve the local business climate by establishing a forum for improving communication between the business community and county government while working to help make Multnomah County an even better place to do business. The BAC is comprised of volunteer members who live or work within Multnomah County and who possess expertise in areas of economic development, entrepreneurship, and social equity. The BAC directly supports the work of Program Offer 10019

(Economic Development).

Members of the BAC are appointed to terms up to two years in length. This Resolution reappoints one BAC member and appoints new members to fill five vacant seats on the BAC.
