General Information

1. What action are you requesting from the Board?

We are requesting approval of the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) for Right of Way services required for the repair of the slide on NW Newberry Road at Milepost 0.5. This is a new IGA.

2. Please provide sufficient background information for the Board and the public to understand this issue. Please note which Program Offer(s) this action affects and how it impacts the results.

NW Newberry Road has been closed since the slide occurred during the winter of 2016/2017. This project will repair the slide and reopen the road. We are currently working on design and right-of-way for this project and expect construction in the spring and summer of 2018. The project will be managed by Multnomah County as under ODOT certification program.

3. Explain the fiscal impact (current year and ongoing).

This IGA covers the right of way requirements for the projects. It also limits ODOT to a maximum of \$5,000 for right of way services performed.

4. Explain any legal and/or policy issues involved.

Property acquisitions and negotiations will be conducted in compliance with Trans-01 and applicable Federal and State law.

5. Explain any citizen and/or other government participation that has or will take place.

Since the slide and roadway closure, Multnomah County staff have put many news releases and established website for the project updates. Public meetings will be held when preliminary design elements are established and right-of-way impact is identified.

Additional specific outreach will be conducted to residents with impacted properties during the design and ROW acquisition phase.
