(Coordination Plan for 1995-96	)	

WHEREAS, State law requires all taxing districts within a county to coordinate property tax plans by holding a meeting to develop a tax coordination plan; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with O.R.S. 310.182 (1) representatives of all units of local government are to be notified of the meeting at least thirty days prior to the last day of the calendar year preceding the calendar year in which the ensuing fiscal year begins; and

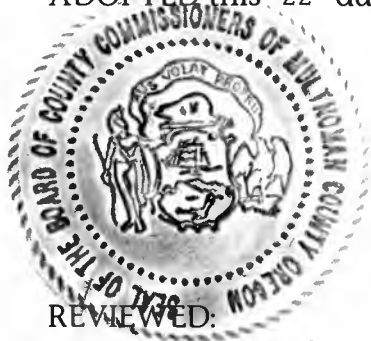
WHEREAS, the governing body of each county or another public agency designated by the county governing body is required to conduct the meeting not later than the last day of the calendar year preceding the calendar year in which the ensuing fiscal year begins; and

WHEREAS, the Multnomah County Tax Supervising and Conservation Commission has performed the coordinating function within Multnomah County during the past three fiscal years; and

WHEREAS, Multnomah County recognizes the importance of continued coordination of public financing measures;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Multnomah County Board of Commissioners designates the Tax Supervising and Conservation Commission to continue its system of coordination for fiscal year 1995-96, and to carry out the notice and meeting requirements set forth in ORS 310.182.
