Description of members to be appointed

At the June 9, 2015 Library Advisory Board meeting, the nominating committee presented the qualifications of four individuals who have indicated their interest in and willingness to serve on the board. The board voted unanimously to recommend the appointment of these candidates:

Sarah Alibabaie is recommended for appointment to position 3 on the Library Advisory Board (LAB). Ms. Alibabaie works at ON Semiconductor and is passionate about the library and its role in the community.

Rob Edmiston is recommended for appointment to position 4 on the LAB. Mr. Edmiston is a public finance professional with expertise in planning and financing public sector capital improvements and analyzing the well-being of public entities.

Lois Leveen is recommended for appointment to position 5 on the LAB. Ms. Leveen is a professional author with experience speaking and networking with librarians throughout the U.S.

Elliot Zais is recommended for appointment to position 11 on the LAB. Mr. Zais has advanced engineering experience and has served on the Alberta Coop Grocery Board.

Timeline for appointment

Sarah Alibabaie will fill position 3, a vacancy created by the end of Bernadette Janét's term. Ms. Alibabaie's first term will run from July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2016.

Rob Edmiston will fill position 4, a vacancy created by the end of George Feldman's term. Mr. Edmiston's term will run from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2019.

Lois Leveen will fill position 5, a vacancy created by the end of Katie Lane's term. Ms. Leveen's term will run from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2019.

Elliot Zais will fill position 11, a vacancy created by the end of José Padin's term. Mr. Zais's term will run from July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2017.
