1. What action are you requesting from the Board?

Approval of a Proclamation to declare December 1-7, 2013 as World AIDS Week in Multnomah County, Oregon to raise awareness about HIV/AIDS and demonstrate community and international solidarity in the face of the epidemic.

In support of the proclamation, Cascade AIDS Project (CAP) will brief the Board on the history of HIV/STI education and outreach in Multnomah County. CAP will share their archives of historical images from the past 29 years of HIV activism. Over the years CAP has collected and carefully archived a vast amount of Portland's HIV history.

Beginning on 12/1/1988, World AIDS Day is a rallying point for raising money, increasing awareness, fighting prejudice and improving education. The World AIDS Day theme for 2013 is **“Getting to Zero: Zero new HIV infections. Zero discrimination. Zero AIDS related deaths”**. World AIDS Day is important in reminding people that HIV has not gone away, and there is still much to be done.
