ORDINANCE NO. 349

An ordinance amending Multnomah County Code: Chapter 6.31 by extending the initial term of office of the Emergency Medical Services Policy Board member elected by the mayors of the east county cities participating in the system.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. FINDINGS

- A. Section 6.31.035 of the Multnomah County Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Ordinance created a three member Policy Board to oversee the operation and regulation of the EMS System.
- B. The members of the policy board are the County Executive, the Portland EMS Commissioner and a representative from the other incorporated cities participating in the system. The representative is appointed by vote of the mayors of those cities to a two year term.
- C. The initial term of the east county representative commenced on October 1, 1980 and expired October 1, 1982.
- D. The east county cities currently participating in the system are Gresham, Troutdale, and Wood Village. Two of these cities will have new mayors after January 1, 1983.
- E. Therefore, the Board finds it desirable that the new mayors select the representative to the EMS Policy Board.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT

Subsection 6.31.035 (B) is amended to read:

- "(B) The representative from the County shall be the County Executive. The representative from the City of Portland shall be the Commissioner in charge of emergency medical services. The representative from the other incorporated cities shall be appointed to two year terms by vote of the mayors of the participating cities. The initial representative shall be determined by vote taken prior to October 1, 1980. The initial term shall run from October 1, 1980 to January 1, 1983. In the event that only one city has agreed to participate by October 1, 1980, the mayor of that city shall serve a two year term as the initial third member of the policy board."

Material underlined is added; material crossed out is deleted.

SECTION 3. AMENDMENT

Subsection 6.31.035 (C) is amended to read:

"(C) Upon the expiration of a term of a member of the policy board that member shall continue to serve until a new member is chosen.  
~~The members of the policy board shall serve without compensation.~~"

SECTION 4. AMENDMENT

Subsection 6.31.035 (C) is added to read:

"(D) The members of the policy board shall serve without compensation."
