An Ordinance in the Matter of the

for the Justice System }

ORDINANCE NO. 303

WHEREAS, the Corrections Classification Advisory Commission reported its recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners on March 16, 1982; and

WHEREAS, Recommendation II entitled "Development of a Classification System Methodology" calls for the immediate contracting of a technical consultant to develop a 'state of the art' decision tree methodology, employing quantitative methods, for making criminal justice intake/assessment/placement decisions; and

WHEREAS, an assessment of this methodology would be in the best interests of the County;

NOW, THEREFORE, Multnomah County ordains as follows: The County shall proceed immediately with the development and execution of a contracted study to test the feasibility of the decision tree methodology and to establish the probable cost of full scale development of a decision tree based classification system and a report shall be given to the Board of County Commissioners on the results of this study within 30 days from the operative date.

This ordinance remains in effect for a period of 30 days from the operative date.

ADOPTED THIS 8th day of April, 1982, being the date of its second reading before the Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County, Oregon.
