WELCOME TO COLUMBIA RIVER CAMP 49 of the Alaska Native Brotherhood. The ANB was organized at Sitka, Alaska in October 1912 to “oppose, discourage, and overcome the narrow injustices of race prejudice, and to commemorate the fine qualities of the Native Races of North America.” Some of the notable ANB accomplishments are (1) Gained recognition of Natives as U.S. citizens, (2) Won the right of Natives to vote, (3) Integrated public schools, (4) Secured direct relief for elderly Natives, (5) Brought the IRA to Alaska Natives (6) Helped champion and elect Natives to the State Legislature, and, (7) Championed passage of the Alaska EEO Laws. There are 51 Native Brotherhood and Sisterhood Camps from Anchorage, Alaska, to Portland, Oregon.

Columbia River Camp 49 of Portland, Oregon, is the newest ANB Camp. It had it's first organizational meeting on March 26, 2009, and received it's Charter during Grand Camp Convention in October. In January 2010, Camp 49 was registered with the State of Oregon as a Domestic Non-Profit Corporation. We have 40 paid-in members from Oregon and SW Washington. Membership is open to everyone regardless of gender, race, color, or creed. Meetings are held the second Saturday of each month (except none in June, July, August), or on Call by the President.

Welcome again to Camp 49. We are proud and happy to have you on our rolls.
