ORDINANCE NO. 41

An Ordinance providing for further requirements for continuing in County service beyond the age of fifty-five (55) years, and amending Article IV of Multnomah County Ordinance No. 25.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. Article IV of Multnomah County Ordinance No. 25 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE IV.

Any employee of the County who is entitled to the benefits under the Retirement System hereby established shall be retired effective the first day of the month following his fifty-fifth birthday unless the employee shall request in writing at least sixty (60) days before and not later than seventy-five (75) days from the effective date of his retirement that he be continued in County service, and such request is approved by the appointing authority and confirmed by the Board of County Commissioners.

No employee entitled to benefits under the Retirement System hereby established shall be subject to involuntary retirement prior to January 1, 1970.

The continuation of service shall be for a period of one (1) year, and for each year thereafter a new request must be made and approved as hereinabove provided. No such employee may be continued in service beyond the age of sixty-five (65) years.
