The Board is being asked to confirm County Chair Jeff Cogen's two new appointments to the Advisory Committee on Sustainability and Innovation as required by Ordinance Number 1171.

In 2010, the Board created the Advisory Committee on Sustainability and Innovation (ACSI) to promote sustainable policies and actions and to advise the county on regional, state or national sustainability policy matters. ACSI members are appointed to two year terms on the committee and are eligible to serve two consecutive terms. Ordinance Number 1171, which established ACSI, calls for the Chair to appoint members to the committee and the Board to confirm those appointments. Two committee members, Sattie Clark and Meera Noris, resigned from the committee leaving two vacancies. The Chair has appointed the following individuals to fill those vacancies: Jackie Yerby and Gladys Ruiz.
