Ordinance No. 8

An Ordinance abolishing the elective offices of county sheriff, assessor, clerk, treasurer, surveyor, constable and district court clerk.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners have elected to not continue in operation any of the above elective county offices that were in operation when the charter of Multnomah County was adopted; and

WHEREAS, no county officer is to be retained by the Board in the official capacity of the office to which he was elected or holding,

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. The elective offices of county sheriff, assessor, clerk, treasurer, surveyor, constable and district court clerk be and they are hereby abolished as of 12:00 o'clock Midnight, December 31, 1966, and the functions, duties and responsibilities of said offices are transferred to the respective departments and officers as designated by ordinances now or hereafter enacted.

Section 2. The terms of office of each of the elective officers holding or elected to the county offices named in this ordinance are hereby terminated as of 12:00 o'clock Midnight, December 31, 1966.

Section 3. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take

effect upon its passage.
