1. What action are you requesting from the Board?

Approval of staffing adjustment resulting from the re-classification of three positions. This change will not impact the Health Department's total FTE for FY2011.

2. Please provide sufficient background information for the Board and the public to understand this issue. Please note which Program Offer this action affects and how it impacts the results.

Reclassify a 0.80 Program Development Specialist to a 0.80 Program Development Specialist Senior, position 709865, in Public Health and Emergency Management. Class Comp approved reclassification effective on 11/06/2009 (reclass #1474). This position is responsible for project management in the area of emergency preparedness and response operations; planning and analysis; design and evaluation of preparedness and response exercises; and administration of communications, record keeping, inventory and role directory for emergencies. This change impacts program offers 40005 – Public Health and Regional Health Systems Emergency.

Reclassify a 1.0 Management Assistant to a 1.0 Program Development Specialist Senior, position 713709, in the Director's Office of the Health Department. Class Comp approved reclassification effective on 07/27/2010 (reclass #1522). The purpose of this position is to develop and promote effective public health advocacy and to shape, advance department-wide strategies for good health and health equity through laws and regulations. This change impacts program offers 40000 – Health Department Leadership Team.

Reclassify a 1.0 Office Assistant Senior to a 1.0 Office Assistant 2, position 711775, in the Community Health Services division of the Health Department. This position was included in the FY11 budget with the expectation that it would be reclassified to an Office Assistant Senior. The reclassification was denied by Class Comp (request #1460), so the position remains its original classification. This action corrects the FY11 budget and restores the position back to its approved job class. This change impacts program offers 40008 – Vector-borne Disease Prevention and Code Enforcement.

The Health Department's budget will have the following changes:

- Permanent personnel budget will decrease by \$21,418.
- Temporary personnel budget will decrease by \$1,664.
- Salary related expense budget will decrease by \$6,958.
- Non-base fringe expense budget will decrease by \$319.
- Insurance benefits budget will decrease by \$1,768.
- Non-base insurance budget will decrease by \$54.
- Professional Services budget will increase by \$32,181.

These changes will have no financial impact on the budget and do not change the Health Department's total FTE.

Change of classification of positions 709865, 713709 and 711775 to better fit the duties of those positions as determined by the Class/Comp Unit of the Central Human Resources.
