ORDER NO. 02-123

Exempting from the Formal Competitive Bid Process the Contract with Signature Graphics until December 31, 2002 for Printing of the Voters' Pamphlets for the November General Election and a Possible December Election

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. The Board, acting in its capacity as the Multnomah County Public Contract Review Board to review, pursuant to PCRB Rule 10.140, a request from the Department of Business and Community Services, Election Division, for exemption from the formal competitive bid process to contract with Signature Graphics for printing the voters' pamphlets for the November election and a possible December election.
- b. As it appears in the memorandum from Mary Shultz, The request for exemption is based upon the fact that an informal exemption currently exists with Signature Graphics, Inc. It is due to expire on September 30, 2002. The bid for Printing, Processing and Production of Multnomah County's Voters' Pamphlets on a Requirements Basis will be closed on September 24, 2002. It is anticipated that a new contract cannot be executed before September 30, 2002. Thus, a formal exemption is requested to bridge the gap between September 30 and the execution of a new contract. The cost for the November voters' pamphlets is estimated to be \$55,000. The cost for the possible December election would be absorbed by the State.
- c. This exemption request is in accord with the requirements of Multnomah County Public Contract Review Board Administrative Rule 10.140.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Orders:

The Contract with Signature Graphics is exempted from the formal competitive bid process until December 31, 2002.
