in Multnomah County's Possession) 91-81

WHEREAS, Multnomah County has possession of nearly 400 tax foreclosed properties, and

WHEREAS, many of these properties are concentrated in a few neighborhoods, and

WHEREAS, the neighborhoods with large concentrations of foreclosed properties are important to the well-being and livability of Multnomah County, and

WHEREAS, proper maintenance of foreclosed properties are important for the continued visibility of many Multnomah County neighborhoods, and

WHEREAS, proper maintenance of foreclosed properties increases the value of neighboring properties, and

WHEREAS, proper maintenance of foreclosed properties can increase the market value of properties, and

WHEREAS, non-profit housing corporations chances of successfully rehabilitating foreclosed properties improve if the properties have been well-maintained, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Multnomah County shall seek to maintain properties in its possession to current neighborhood standards within budgetary constraints, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Chair is directed to develop specific measures that shall meet neighborhood standards.
