And, i will be sending as many copies of 'this letter AND the three sheeter' to as many of the government employees, you list as Congressional Advisors, as possible.

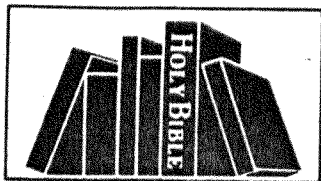
Plus, i will send copies to as many of the Allied Organizations [you listed] as i can afford.

ASSAULT WEAPONS

The official Department of Defense definition of an assault weapon is one that will fire either in the fully automatic mode (by which the weapon continues to discharge bullets in rapid succession as long as the trigger is depressed), or, by turning a selector control, will fire in the semi-automatic mode, by which the weapon will discharge one bullet for each press of the trigger.

Generally, a weapon, fired in the fully automatic mode is not very accurate. In comprehensive tests, it is only the first bullet that leaves a fully automatic weapon that can be, with any assurance, considered accurate. On the other hand, the semi-automatic weapon can be aimed very quickly between trigger squeezes; therefore, it is by far the more deadly weapon. Consequently, when a guerrilla force, or a population in rebellion, is in the field without a large arsenal for the supply of ammunition, the semi-automatic is more effective by a factor of ten.

The forgoing discussion is the real reason why, Mr. Metzenbaum in the Senate, and Mr. Berman in the House, are pushing for what they have termed "assault weapons" to be outlawed. They are wanting not only to stop the sale of such weapons but they are demanding that such weapons already in the hands of American citizens be confiscated.

It isn't the loss of power to the electronic funds transfer of the Central Bank that is the great danger to our

freedom, liberty and security. These two bills, being pushed by these two "Johnny-come-latelys" to the American heritage, are the real threat to our security.

The whole argument being orchestrated throughout the nation on talk shows, the news media, and even in churches, is not over our right to "go deer hunting with an assault rifle." It is our inalienable God-ordained right to defend our life, liberty and property from whatever is the threat. That threat can be so-called "terrorists" from without or from within our country.

The second amendment gives us not the right but the duty, to defend our life, liberty, property and pursuit of happiness from a government that has turned despotic.

As late as 1939, the United States Supreme Court, drawing from Constitutional and historical documents, interpreted the original intent of the word "militia" as to mean one comprised of "all males physically capable of acting in concert for the common defense (of the people, not the government -ed.), and further, that ordinarily when called for service these men were expected to appear bearing arms supplied by themselves and of the kind in common usage at the time." In common usage today is the semi-automatic rifle that holds thirty or more rounds in a bottom loading clip and may, or may not, have a folding stock!

The second amendment rights is not to give us the "license" to go deer hunting. The second amendment gives us not the right but the duty, to defend our life, liberty, property and pursuit of happiness from a government that has turned despotic.

When these two men, and there are many others, self-styled experts in our

Christian Republic heritage figure out that the old "battle-field" weapons could very easily be more of a threat to their plans than even the "assault weapons", they will want to outlaw and confiscate those too. Make no mistake about this.

God knows that abortion is murder. There have been 12-15 million murders of unborn babies in the past 10 years or so and that is an abomination to God, no matter how it is rationalized.

But this point must be made crystal clear to all freedom loving Americans everywhere. Since the start of this century, all countries of the world whose governments have disarmed their citizens, have murdered hundreds of times more people than the abortion mills have. Those little babies in their mother's wombs couldn't defend themselves. GUNS ARE FOR KILLING

Citizens are the targets of criminals and gangs — not the police! Citizens are on the front lines — the police are backups! Who, then, is really out-gunned?

The argument for banning so many firearms is that "We the people..." have supposedly given up our rights to defend ourselves because we have police departments who are charged with that responsibility. Of course, they only have this responsibility when they are near or see someone violating our rights.

We have also designated and are paying for firemen to put out the fire at our home or office. If we were to follow the gun ban logic to its obvious conclusion, we should all turn in our fire extinguishers and garden hoses.

Firemen could claim that the few seconds delay before calling the fire department while we try to put out the little fire ourselves with a fire extinguisher, is sufficient to endanger the lives of the firemen. Obviously, if we delay even a few seconds because we have that concealed fire extinguisher the blaze will be bigger and more dangerous by the time they arrive on the scene.

Logical?

Those who have sworn to uphold the Constitution seem to be hell-bent on finding ways to circumvent it almost the instant they are elected to public office. There are about 6.5 million Swiss. If we can believe McPhee, that means there is one assault rifle out there for each 10 Swiss. Yet with all that destructive capability in the hands of the Swiss populace, the violent crime rate is minuscule when compared with our own.

Could it be that the crime rate of a nation is more closely related to its social fabric than to the presence of guns?

Agency sets gun survey

The federal agency that enforces national gun laws will soon begin a survey to determine whether military-style semiautomatic rifles are used for target shooting and hunting.

The study would provide evidence on whether the decision last week by the Bush administration to suspend indefinitely the importing of five kinds of such rifles was correct and should be made permanent and whether other foreign guns should be added to the list.

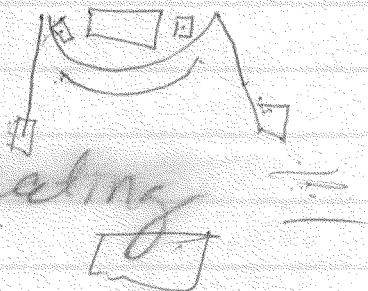

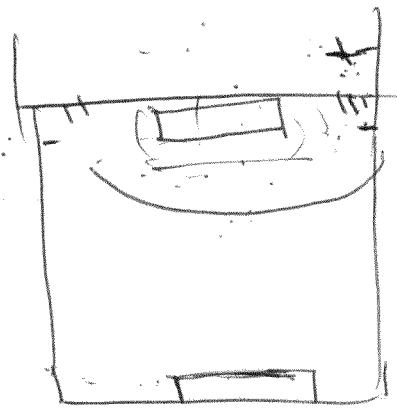

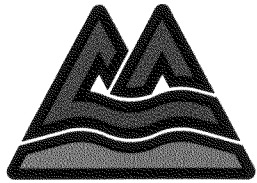

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

FOR MULTNOMAH COUNTY, OREGON

ORDINANCE NO. ____

An ordinance prohibiting possession of a loaded firearm and discharge of a firearm in a public place, and imposing fees for concealed handgun licenses and background security checks required by state law.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section I. Findings

A. The proliferation of firearms poses a present and serious threat to the health, safety and security of the residents of Multnomah County.

B. Nationally, approximately 1,200 people are killed each year in accidental shootings, including 365 children. For every child killed through the negligent use of firearms, 10 are injured.

C. In Multnomah County, approximately two persons per week are killed from the intentional or accidental use of firearms.

D. The Oregon Courts have recognized that the constitutional right to bear arms is not absolute; the constitution allows government to enact reasonable regulations, such as regulations over the manner of possessing firearms.

E. The Oregon Court of Appeals specifically upheld the

1 constitutionalty of Portland's ordinance making it unlawful
2 for any person to carry a loaded firearm in a public place
3 (State v. Boyce, 61 Or App 662, 658 P2d 577 (1983), rev den,
4 295 Or 122).

5 F. The 1989 Oregon Legislature enacted laws (1989 Oregon
6 Laws, Chapter 839) to restrict access to firearms and
7 authorized local governments to regulate the possession of
8 firearms and ammunition in public places.

9 G. Although the City of Portland presently bans
10 possession of loaded firearms in public places and the
11 discharge of firearms in public, those restrictions do not
12 apply in unincorporated parts of Multnomah County. The
13 restrictions are reasonable and should apply in the
14 unincorporated area.

15 H. The Board has considered public testimony concerning
16 the need to restrict assault weapons and other firearms and has
17 determined that the subject calls for a coordinated approach
18 supported by all municipalities in the County. Developing such
19 a coordinated approach will take time. Pending development of
20 a consensus among local governments, the more limited measures
21 reflected in this ordinance should be adopted.

22 I. The 1989 legislature also imposed the following
23 administrative responsibilities on the Multnomah County
24 Sheriff's Department:

25 (1) Conduct criminal and mental health background
26 checks on purchasers of handguns from federally licensed

dealers.

(2) Notify dealers by certified mail of disqualified handgun purchasers.

(3) Conduct background checks of purchasers of long guns for study purposes.

(4) Submit monthly reports to the Oregon State Police regarding concealed weapons permits issued and denied; notify Oregon State Police of disqualifications for handgun and long gun purchases.

(5) Review an increased number of applications for concealed weapons permits; document reasons for denial.

J. It is in the best interest of the citizens of the County that the costs of performing these responsibilities be borne by purchasers of guns in the County. The fees in this ordinance are intended to cover only the costs imposed on the County by such purchasers.

Section II. Definitions

A. "Concealed handgun license" is as defined in ORS 166.290.

B. "Firearm" is as defined in ORS 166.210 and means a weapon, by whatever name known, which is designed to expel a projectile by the action of smokeless powder and which is readily capable of use as a weapon.

C. "Public place" is as defined in ORS 161.015(9) and means a place to which the general public has access and

1 includes, but is not limited to, hallways, lobbies, and other
2 parts of apartment houses and hotels not constituting rooms or
3 apartments designed for actual residence, and highways,
4 streets, schools, places of amusement, parks, playgrounds, and
5 premises used in connection with public passenger
6 transportation.

7
8 Section III. Carrying and Discharge of Firearms

9 A. It is unlawful for any person to carry a firearm,
10 loaded or unloaded, in a park, public building, or school.

11 B. It is unlawful for any person in a public place to
12 carry a firearm upon the person, or in a vehicle under the
13 person's control or in which the person is an occupant, unless
14 all ammunition has been removed from the chamber and from the
15 cylinder, clip, or magazine. A person who violates this
16 section is subject to penalty even if the person did not know
17 that ammunition was in the cylinder, chamber, clip or magazine.

18 C. It is unlawful for any person to fire or discharge a
19 firearm in a public place.

20 D. In a public place, it is unlawful for any person
21 carrying a firearm upon the person, or in a vehicle under the
22 person's control or in which the person is an occupant, to
23 refuse to permit a peace officer to inspect that firearm after
24 the peace officer has identified himself as such.

25 E. The prohibitions in Subsections (A), (B), and (C) of
26 this Section do not apply to a peace officer acting within the

dealer to submit a required fee, but shall not refuse
to conduct a background check for that reason. The
fee shall be annually reviewed by the Sheriff, who
shall report to the Board on the sufficiency of the
fee to cover the costs of conducting the required
checks.

Section V. Penalties

A. Violation of Section III of this ordinance shall be
punishable by a fine up to \$500 and forfeiture of the weapon.

B. If, after investigation or adjudication, it is

determined the weapon was not possessed, carried or used unlawfully, it shall be released to the owner if the owner files a written claim with the Multnomah County Sheriff's Office.

C. If there is a question as to ownership or right to possession, the weapon shall be released as ordered by the court in a proceeding initiated under ORS 133.633 to 133.663 by any person claiming ownership or right to possession.

Section VI. Severability Clause

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional, that portion shall be considered a separate, distinct and independent provision, and the holdings shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

ORDINANCE NO. _____

An ordinance prohibiting possession of a loaded firearm and discharge of a firearm in a public place, regulating possession of assault weapons in public places, establishing a firearms safety training course, and imposing fees.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section I. Findings

A. The proliferation of firearms poses a present and serious threat to the health, safety and security of the residents of Multnomah County.

B. Nationally, approximately 1,200 people are killed each year in accidental shootings, including 365 children. For every child killed through the negligent use of firearms, 10 are injured.

C. In Multnomah County, approximately two persons per week are killed from the intentional or accidental use of firearms.

D. The Oregon Courts have recognized that the constitutional right to bear arms does not cover all firearms and is not absolute. Advanced weapons designed for military use are not covered by the constitution (State v. Kessler). Additionally, with regard to arms that are covered by the state

1 constitution, government can enact reasonable regulations, such
2 as regulations over the manner of possessing such arms (State
3 v. Delgado).

4 E. The Oregon Court of Appeals specifically upheld the
5 constitutionality of Portland's ordinance making it unlawful
6 for any person to carry a loaded firearm in a public place
7 (State v. Boyce, 61 Or App 662, 658 P2d 577 (1983), rev den,
8 295 Or 122).

9 F. The 1989 Oregon Legislature enacted laws (Or Laws
10 1989, ch. 839) to restrict access to firearms and authorized
11 local governments to regulate the possession of firearms and
12 ammunition in public places.

13 G. Although the City of Portland presently bans
14 possession of loaded firearms in public places and the
15 discharge of firearms in public, those restrictions do not
16 apply in unincorporated parts of Multnomah County. The
17 restrictions are reasonable and should apply in the
18 unincorporated area.

19 H. Assault weapons are identified as such herein because
20 their design, high rate of fire and capacity to cause injury
21 render them a substantial danger to human life and safety,
22 outweighing any function as a legitimate sports or recreational
23 firearm.

24 I. The proliferation and use of assault weapons pose a
25 present and serious threat to the health, safety and security
26 of the residents of Multnomah County.

1 J. A recent study has shown that while assault weapons
2 account for one million of the estimated 200 million firearms
3 in America, they were used in one of every ten crimes that
4 resulted in a firearms trace last year. The increasing and
5 disproportionate use of assault weapons for criminal purposes
6 endangers both the public and law enforcement personnel.

7 K. Recognizing that assault weapons pose a threat to
8 public safety, and with the recommendation from the Bureau of
9 Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms that assault weapons serve no
10 legitimate sporting or recreational purpose, President Bush
11 stopped the importation of certain assault weapons.

12 L. According to the Report and Recommendation of the
13 Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms, dated July 6, 1989,
14 the following characteristics accurately describe assault
15 weapons and distinguish them from traditional sporting rifles:
16 (1) they are semi-automatic versions of machineguns; (2) they
17 have a large magazine capacity; and (3) they have other
18 military features (such as folding/telescoping stocks,
19 well-defined pistol grips, ability to accept bayonet, and flash
20 suppressors).

21 M. Law enforcement organizations including The National
22 Sheriffs' Association, the International Association of Chiefs
23 of Police, the National Association of Police Organizations,
24 the Police Executive Research Forum, and the Fraternal Order of
25 Police have called for a national ban on the production and
26 sale of assault weapons.

1 N. The 1989 legislature imposed the following
2 administrative responsibilities on the Multnomah County
3 Sheriff's Department:

4 (1) Conduct criminal and mental health background
5 checks on purchasers of handguns from federally licensed
6 dealers.

7 (2) Notify dealers by certified mail of disqualified
8 handgun purchasers.

9 (3) Conduct background checks of purchasers of long
10 guns for study purposes.

11 (4) Submit monthly reports to the Oregon State Police
12 regarding concealed weapons permits issued and denied;
13 notify Oregon State Police of disqualifications for handgun
14 and long gun purchases.

15 (5) Review an increased number of applications for
16 concealed weapons permits; document reasons for denial.

17 O. It is in the best interest of the citizens of the

MAC-10 and MAC-11,
Scarab Skorpion,
Sterling MK-7,
Uzi pistol,

(3) All of the following shotguns:

Franchi SPAS-12 and LAW-12,
Striker-12 and Street Sweeper

(4) Any copy of a firearm listed in subsections (1),
(2) or (3) by the same or other manufacturers, including,
but not limited to, commercial manufacturers and private
individuals, which is identical or has slight modifications
or enhancements such as a folding or retractable stock,
different sights, case deflector for left-handed shooters,
shorter barrel, stock of different composition, larger
ammunition capacity, different caliber, or bayonet mount.

1 B. "Assault weapon", as used in this chapter, does not
2 include any of the following:

7 (3) Any handgun that is a revolver or conventional

The fees collected under Section V of this ordinance shall be placed in an account dedicated exclusively to covering the costs of firearms regulation. Funds in the account shall be expended for the following: (1) background checks required by state law; (2) concealed weapons license investigations; and (3) gun safety and education and enforcement of gun laws.

Section VII. Safety and Education Course

A. By July 1, 1990, the Multnomah County Sheriff's Office shall develop a firearms safety and education course to be available to any Multnomah County resident. The Sheriff may develop the course in conjunction with nationally or state recognized entities that foster education about firearms.

B. The course shall emphasize safe firearm use and storage; laws regarding gun possession, use and transfer; the gravity of harms guns may cause; methods of protecting firearms from theft; and other topics as the Sheriff deems appropriate.

Page

1 The course shall reasonably accommodate citizens who do not
2 speak English, and handicapped citizens.

3 C. A person who successfully completes the course shall
4 receive a training certificate.

5 D. The Sheriff may certify firearms safety and education
6 courses offered by other organizations and may issue training



Massacre in Montreal

'I want the women,' the killer said, smiling

The 60 University of Montreal engineering students were a day away from final exams, grinding through a late-afternoon class. A smiling young man who walked in seemed outfitted for a bizarre, end-of-term prank: hunting clothes, what looked like a rifle and bandoliers of bullets across his chest. The class laughed as he ordered the women to one side of the room and the men to the other. Then he fired a shot past a student's head, and they knew this was no campus gag. "You're all feminists," 25-year-old Marc Lepine said, ordering the men to leave before he pulled the trigger on the worst mass murder in Canadian history. He gunned down 14 women and wounded 13 other people in a 45-minute rampage, then shot himself.

Lepine's background had a familiar ring in the aftermath of yet another massacre—a reclusive loser, embittered by disappointment and easily able to obtain a powerful firearm. The son of Algerian and French Canadian parents who separated when he was 7, Gamil Gharbi took his mother's maiden name (and a new first one) when he was 18. At a 1976 divorce hearing, his mother testified that her husband frequently beat the child. Lepine had little success with women and kept to himself, playing loud music in his apartment late into the night. A neighbor said she once heard him laughing—alone—every evening for several weeks. Rejected by the Canadian military, he attended junior college but aspired to enter Ecole Polytechnique, the university-affiliated engineering school that became his killing ground. He left a note blaming

feminists for his failures, and promising to emulate Canadian forces Cpl. Denis Lortie, whose 1984 assault on the Quebec Legislature left three dead. He also listed 15 prominent Quebec women, including a provincial cabinet minister, but made no threats.

Lepine began his rampage on the building's second floor, killing a female office worker before entering the class and fatally shooting six more women. He then stalked the hallways, shooting his way downstairs to the first-floor cafeteria, where he killed an additional three. Four more women died in another third-floor classroom. He worked methodically, according to witnesses, stopping once to reload his semiautomatic rifle and spelling out his chilling objective: "I want the women." Survivors say he smiled as he hunted his prey. "It was, you know, a normal smile," one student recalled. "Nothing crazy, just like he was having a good time."

The massacre rocked a country that recorded just 575 homicides in 1988 (New York City alone had over 1,800). It also renewed a debate on the availability of firearms. Lepine, who had no criminal record, obtained a gun permit by paying a \$10 fee and swearing to no history of mental illness. Justice Minister Doug Lewis promised tougher gun laws but added: "You can't legislate against insanity." Laws won't help survivors free themselves of their memories. "It was like a bad dream where you wake up before the trigger is pulled," says one. "Only in this dream you don't wake up and the trigger was pulled."

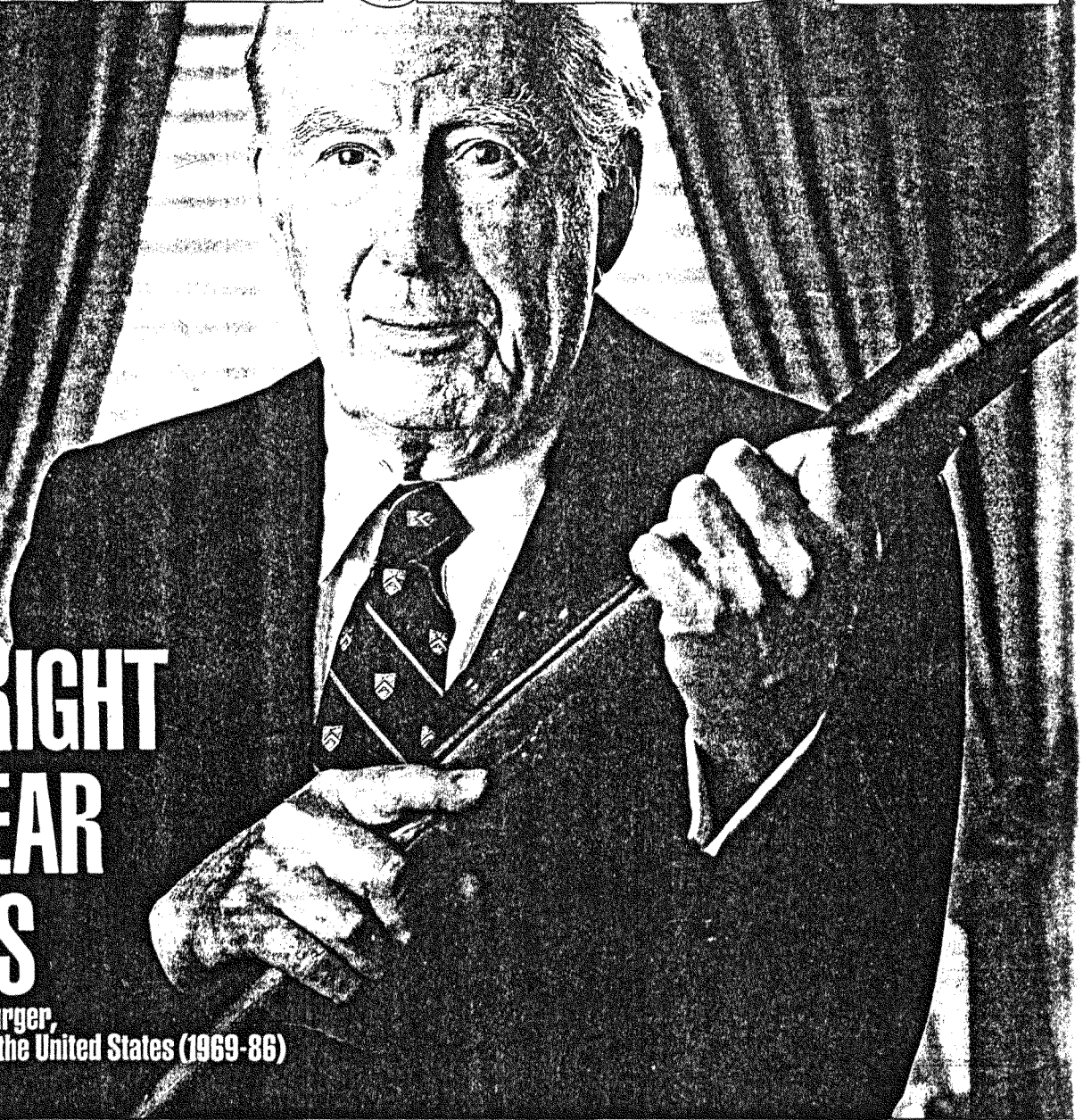

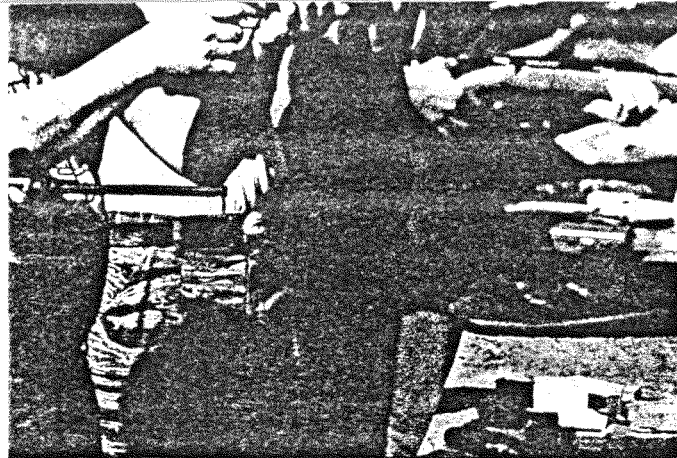

The Right To Bear Arms

Warren E. Burger was born in St. Paul, Minn., on Constitution Day, Sept. 17, 1907. After graduating from St. Paul (now William Mitchell) College of Law magna cum laude in 1931, he served as an adjunct professor there while engaged in private practice. In 1953, President Eisenhower appointed him Assistant Attorney General of the United States and three years later to the U.S. Court of Appeals. In May 1969, President Nixon appointed him Chief Justice of the United States. He served in that office until September 1986, when he was appointed chairman of the Commission on the Bicentennial of the United States Constitution by President Reagan—a position he continues to hold. Chief Justice Burger has owned sporting guns all his life but says he has had little time for hunting in recent years.

OUR METROPOLITAN centers, and some suburban communities of America, are setting new records for homicides by handguns. Many of our large centers have up to 10 times the murder rate of all of Western Europe. In 1988, there were 9000 handgun murders in America. Last year, Washington, D.C., alone had more than 400 homicides—setting a new record for our capital.

The Constitution of the United States, in its Second Amendment, guarantees a "right of the people to keep and bear arms." However, the meaning of this clause cannot be understood except by looking to the purpose, the setting and the objectives of the draftsmen. The first 10 amendments—the Bill of Rights—were not drafted at Philadelphia in 1787; that document came two years later than the Constitution. Most of the states already had bills of rights, but the Constitution might not have been ratified in 1788 if the states had not had assurances that a national Bill of Rights would soon be added.

People of that day were apprehensive about the new "monster" national government presented to them, and this helps

explain the language and purpose of the Second Amendment. A few lines after the First Amendment's guarantees—against "establishment of religion," "free exercise" of religion, free speech and free press—came a guarantee that grew out of the deep-seated fear of a "national" or "standing" army. The same First Congress that approved the right to keep and bear arms also limited the national army to 840 men; Congress in the Second Amendment then provided:

"A well regulated Militia, being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people to keep and bear Arms, shall not be infringed."

In the 1789 debate in Congress on James Madison's proposed Bill of Rights,

Is there any question that a citizen has the right to own and keep an automobile? Yet we accept the state's power to regulate its purchase and to license the vehicle and its driver. Should guns be any different?



Elbridge Gerry argued that a state militia was necessary:

"to prevent the establishment of a standing army, the bane of liberty... Whenever governments mean to invade the rights and liberties of the people, they always attempt to destroy the militia in order to raise an army upon their ruins."

We see that the need for a state militia was the predicate of the "right" guaranteed; in short, it was declared "necessary" in order to have a state military force to protect the security of the state.

That Second Amendment clause must be read as though the word "because" was the opening word of the guarantee. Today, of course, the "state militia" serves a very different purpose. A huge national defense establishment has taken over the role of the militia of 200 years ago.

Some have exploited these ancient concerns, blurring sporting guns—rifles, shotguns and even machine pistols—with all firearms, including what are now called "Saturday night specials." There is, of course, a great difference between sporting guns and handguns. Some regulation of handguns has long been accepted as imperative; laws relating to "concealed weapons" are common. That we may be "over-regulated" in some areas

of life has never held us back from more regulation of automobiles, airplanes, motorboats and "concealed weapons."

Let's look at the history. First, many of the 3.5 million people living in the 13 original Colonies depended on wild game for food, and a good many of them required firearms for their defense from marauding Indians—and later from the French and English. Underlying all these needs was an important concept that each able-bodied man in each of the 13 independent states had to help or defend his state.

The early opposition to the idea of national or standing armies was maintained under the Articles of Confederation; that confederation had no standing army and wanted none. The state militia—essentially a part-time citizen army, as in Switzerland today—was the only kind of "army" they wanted. From the time of the Declaration of Independence through the victory at Yorktown in 1781, George Washington, as the commander-in-chief of these volunteer militia armies, had to depend upon the states to send those volunteers.

When a company of New Jersey militia volunteers reported for duty to Washington at Valley Forge, the men initially declined to take an oath to "the United States," maintaining, "Our country is New Jersey." Massachusetts Bay men, Virginians and others felt the same way. To the American of the 18th century, his state was his country, and his freedom was defended by his militia.

and their fathers and grandfathers before them, remembered how monarchs had used standing armies to oppress their ancestors in Europe. Americans wanted no part of this. A state militia, like a rifle and powder horn, was as much a part of life as the automobile is today; pistols were largely for officers, aristocrats—and dueling.

Against this background, it was not surprising that the provision concerning firearms emerged in very simple terms with the significant predicate—basing the right on the necessity for a "well regulated militia," a state army.

In the two centuries since then—with two world wars and some lesser ones—it has become clear, sadly, that we have no choice but to maintain a standing national army while still maintaining a "militia" by way of the National Guard, which can be swiftly integrated into the national defense forces.

Americans also have a right to defend their homes, and we need not challenge that. Nor does anyone seriously question that the Constitution protects the right of hunters to own and keep sporting guns for hunting game any more than anyone would challenge the right to own and keep fishing rods and other equipment for fishing—or to own automobiles. To the Editor,

Your editorial of March 11, 1990, "Toward Peaceful Streets" continues to mislead and deceive our local population. Keeping it as brief as possible, I will address those items which you covered.

First, there is absolutely no correlation between safety and the disarming of law-abiding citizens. In fact, FBI statistics and other studies consistently prove that just the opposite relationship exists. The easier it becomes to prey on the general population, the more bold the criminal element will become. Criminals can always be armed as they are everywhere in the world. This happens even in those places that have complete prohibition of private ownership of firearms.

Your comments on semiautomatic firearms exposes your complete lack of understanding of the facts and/or your utter disregard of the truth. Fact (1): semiautomatic firearms have existed for over 110 years and remain essentially unchanged mechanically. This was attested to by BATF (Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms) in recent Congressional hearings. Fact (2): expert testimony given at both National and California hearings consistently show that the cartridges used in what the various media label as assault rifles

(a deliberately misleading misnomer) are actually considerably less powerful than those used in many common hunting rifles that have been in service since the 1860's. Fact (3): currently available data from the Multnomah County Medical Office (1988) reveals that there has been not one incident of the misuse of a semiautomatic rifle in the county relating to suicides, homicides, or accidental deaths.

For the Oregon Legislature to meet in 1991 to pass more stringent laws seems quite unlikely now. The only reason they were able to get a sufficient consensus to pass HB3470 was the inclusion of Sec. 38 which was designed to prohibit local jurisdictions from instituting their own brand of gun control. For the last three months the Speaker of the House has seemed unwilling to honor her commitment to the drafters of the legislation by telling the Multnomah County Commissioners that they have exceeded their authority. The author of Sec. 38, Rep. Kelly Clark, who was also the chief mediator during the bills adoption, testified on December 21, 1989 that it would be extremely difficult to consider this topic in a favorable light in the '91 Legislature if the County Commission proceeded in this direction. Speaker Katz thought it sufficient that she would merely not support the ordinance, while fully knowing that this law was in violation of the legislative intent of the pre-emption language in Sec. 38 of HB3470.

It is obvious that while the pro-firearms representatives bargained in good faith, the other side did not. Anti-gun zealots of the radical fringe will have an impossibly arduous task

recruiting support from anyone who is pro-firearms now that the obvious is out: The Anti's didn't bargain in good faith and they never intended to bargain in good faith! The gutting or repeal of HB3470 now becomes a distinct possibility.

There are several things wrong with allowing the County to charge a fee for the background checks. First, local jurisdictions have for 20 years performed background checks of handgun purchasers. The only additional work would be for purchasers of long guns who do not possess concealed handgun permits, since they have already been pre-screened. This is minimal additional work.

Second, as this is a public safety issue, the traditional and proper way to pay for such services is through general revenues, as everyone benefits from them. Certainly, we do not expect an individual to be billed for police assistance should a burglar break down his/her door. We don't even bill crooks for their trials.

Third, to propose that a tax be charged on the exercise of a Constitutionally guaranteed Right is repugnant. This constitutes a contemptible poll tax. While there are obviously costs in the administration of elections, these costs must be borne by the society at large. We remind everyone that the Southern States restricted severely and unconstitutionally the exercise of franchise by minorities through the imposition of a \$10.00 poll tax payable in silver. Have Bauman, Anderson, and Kafoury added elitism to racism or do they simply disregard the Constitution which they have sworn to uphold?

The Oregonian's Editors apprehension over the number of concealed handgun permits is unjustified. The neighboring Counties of Clackamas and Columbia and the entire State of Washington have traditionally issued permits on demand to people possessing clean records. These jurisdictions have experienced negligible problems. Multnomah County should expect better results as the new law has the most restrictive permit issuing criteria in the United States. Multnomah County might even reasonably anticipate a reduction in overall crime as criminals fear confrontation with an armed victim or homeowner even more than they fear the police. People should remember that the abuses under the old permit system were actually those committed by sheriffs like Fred Pearce and Don Clark. Those sheriffs unjustly restricted permits to personal friends and political patrons.

We simply cannot expect Imperial Commissioners Bauman, Anderson, and Kafoury to leave the ordinance as it is, because all have indicated that it is just a "good first step" and that it should be "extended to other county and city governments." The ordinance as written is a prelude to requiring that everyone must obtain two different types of permits from every jurisdiction through which they travel for each and every firearm that they own. We don't need an attorney to tell us that this flagrantly violates our Rights.

Lastly, keep in mind that the U.S. Supreme Court has held that criminals cannot be required to participate in, nor be prosecuted for failure to abide by, a permit system as this constitutes an

unconstitutional infringement of their 5th Amendment Rights against self-incrimination. *Only law-abiding citizens can be harassed in this fashion. Why?*

Then again, Commissioners Bauman, Anderson, and Kafoury and Speaker Katz: Why? Why? And again, why?
