

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
FOR MULTNOMAH COUNTY, OREGON

ORDINANCE NO. 217

An ordinance relating to the retirement system for Multnomah County employees; and amending Ordinance No. 179.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 2.02-2 of Ordinance 179 is amended to read:

"Qualified county service" means all county service except in a job category covered by:

- (a) The Sworn Law Enforcement Officers' Retirement Fund subject to the exception contained in 2.05; or
- (b) Any other separate retirement fund maintained by the county or another governmental agency.

Section 2. Article II of Ordinance 179 is amended by inserting the following subsection after Subsection 2.04-4:

"2.05 Credit for other County Service  
A person who transfers from a position in county service covered by the Sworn Law Enforcement Officers' Retirement Fund to a position in county service not covered by that fund or any separate retirement fund shall have counted as qualified county service the period of county service prior to the date of the transfer."

Section 3. Section 3.02 of Ordinance 179 is amended by inserting the following subsection after Subsection 3.02-3:


"3.02-4 There shall be transferred to the plan from the Sworn Law Enforcement Officers' Retirement Fund the accumulated employee contributions of any participant who transfers to a position in county service under 2.05. The transfer of contributions shall be made within 30 days of the date of participation in this system."

Section 4. Section 6.04 of Ordinance 179 is amended by inserting the following subsection:


"6.04-7 A participant upon whose behalf a transfer is made under 3.02-4 shall be paid the difference between the participant's contributions to the Sworn Law Enforcement Officers' Retirement System and the amount which the participant would have contributed had the period of county service covered by that other system been served under this system."

Adopted this 10th day of January, 1980, being the date of its second reading before the Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County, Oregon.
