General Information

1. What action are you requesting from the Board?

The Departments of County Services and County Management are asking the Board to approve an amendment to an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Portland for funding of the Sellwood Bridge (Agreement) to better align the County's receipt of City funding to the currently expected project completion timeline.

2. Please provide sufficient background information for the Board and the public to understand this issue. Please note which Program Offer(s) this action affects and how it impacts the results.

The current Agreement with the City commits the City to funding up to \$86 million for costs related to the Sellwood Bridge replacement project. The City has paid the County \$80.5 million to date. This amendment sets a new date for the City to pay any remaining amounts owed to the County. This date will be on or before June 30, 2020.

Amendment revises terms under which the County receives payment from the City.
