Adopting the 2012 Multnomah County Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. The Federal Stafford Act requires the creation of a local natural hazard mitigation plan.
- b. The plan:
 - analyzes groups of natural hazards that have historically occurred in the County and makes a projection of where such hazards may occur in the future;
 - takes into consideration County activity in the areas of zoning, land use planning, and conservation;
 - determines the magnitude of damage that such future hazards may inflict;
 - determines what infrastructure is at risk of such hazards;
 - describes mitigation projects which, when carried out, will lessen the chance for damage or destruction due to a natural disaster or emergency; and
 - allows the County to apply for Pre Disaster Mitigation funding.
- c. This plan updates the plan previously adopted by Resolution 05-073.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:

1. To adopt the attached 2012 Multnomah County Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan.
2. To submit the Plan for approval to the State of Oregon and the Federal Emergency Management Agency.
