### General Information

#### 1. What action are you requesting from the Board?

Approval of an amendment of an IGA with the State of Oregon for the Sellwood Bridge project.

#### 2. Please provide sufficient background information for the Board and the public to understand this issue. Please note which Program Offer this action affects and how it impacts the results.

The Oregon Department of Transportation has asked the county to clarify language in our IGA for the Sellwood Bridge. The county has developed a funding plan which involves potential deferral of construction of the interchange at the west end should full funding for the complete interchange not be secured by March 2012. The board adopted the existing funding plan, with an alternative to build an interim interchange until such time as funding for a full interchange could be secured. This IGA clarifies the role of Multnomah County with regard to funding the future build out of the interchange. It also clarifies some of the insurance requirements of the project.

#### 3. Explain the fiscal impact (current year and ongoing).

No fiscal impact in current year. Future fiscal impact is that the county is responsible for securing funding in the event that we build a temporary interchange and then need to build the full interchange in the future. The Board of County Commissioners has already approved this approach.

**4. Explain any legal and/or policy issues involved.**

This amends Multnomah County's current IGA with the state of Oregon (through the Department of Transportation).

Multnomah County has conducted an extensive public involvement process with multiple stakeholders on the Sellwood Bridge replacement project.
