

## BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

## FOR MULTNOMAH COUNTY, OREGON

ORDINANCE No. 544

An Ordinance establishing an Exception to Statewide Planning Goal No. 3 for certain properties.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. Findings.

- A. The Planning Commission considered the Comprehensive Framework Plan designation for Tax Lots '15' and '16' of Lot 19, Banner Acres (1986 Assessor's Map) at its meeting of November 10, 1986.
- B. The Planning Commission recommends to the Board that the Comprehensive Framework Plan designation for the above described property be changed from Exclusive Farm Use to Multiple Use Agriculture based on the Findings contained in their Decision on PR 6-86.
- C. The Board of County Commissioners concur in the Planning Commission's recommendation and adopts the Planning Commission's Findings

Section 2. Amendment of Comprehensive Framework Plan.

The Comprehensive Framework Plan designation for Tax Lots '15' and '16' of Lot 19, Banner Acres is changed from Exclusive Farm Use to Multiple Use Agriculture.

Adoption.

This Ordinance being necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the people of Multnomah County, shall take effect on January 15, 1987.

Adopted this 16th day of December, 1986, being the date of its second reading before the Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County, Oregon.
