

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
FOR MULTNOMAH COUNTY, OREGON
ORDINANCE NO. 253

An ordinance creating a Cable Communications Task Force for Multnomah County.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

SECTION 1.

There is created a Cable Communications Task Force for Multnomah County.

SECTION 2.

The Task Force shall be composed of 15 members appointed by the County Executive, with the approval of the Board of County Commissioners.

SECTION 3.

The Task Force shall study cable communications in Multnomah County and make recommendations to the County Executive and the Board of County Commissioners on or before June 30, 1981 on the following matters:

- recommendations relating to soliciting, processing and awarding a Cable Communications franchise in Multnomah County
- recommendations relating to proposed changes, if any, to the present Multnomah County ordinance relating to Cable Television franchising (Multnomah County Code Chapter 6.60).

ADOPTION

This Ordinance, being necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the people of Multnomah County, shall take effect on Nov. 16, 1980 according to Section 5.50 of the Charter of Multnomah County

Adopted on October 16, 1980, the date of its second reading.
