General Information

1. What action are you requesting from the Board?

Resolution to repeal Resolution 88-176 and adopt and updated resolution regarding the operation of the jail system Inmate Welfare Fund.

2. Please provide sufficient background information for the Board and the public to understand this issue. Please note which Program Offer this action affects and how it impacts the results.

This resolution documents current business practices related to the Inmate Welfare Fund regarding purpose, use of funds and revenues, and also aligns current practices with ORS 421.068, which dictates use of certain funds for the Department of Corrections. Inmate Welfare is currently held in Program Offer #60019, "Inmate Welfare and Commissary."

3. Explain the fiscal impact (current year and ongoing).

Inmate Welfare is budgeted at \$668,127 for FY2012. Costs for the program and recovered entirely through non-general fund revenue sources.

4. Explain any legal and/or policy issues involved.

ORS 421.068 outlines the standards for revenues from certain sources being used to enhance inmate activities and programs, and limiting those funds to benefiting the general inmate population through enhancement of inmates activities and programs including educational programs.

5. Explain any citizen and/or other government participation that has or will take place.

Inmate welfare supports materials used by volunteers in the jail system involved in educational and religious program enhancements.
