

**Minutes of the Board of Commissioners
Public Budget Hearing #C held at
Multnomah County Building, Board Room
501 SE Hawthorne Blvd., Portland, Oregon
Wednesday, June 10, 2015**

Chair Deborah Kafoury called the meeting to order at 6:06 p.m. with Vice-Chair Jules Bailey and Commissioners Loretta Smith, Diane McKeel and Judy Shiprack present.

Also attending were Lynda Grow, Board Clerk, and Marina Baker, Assistant Board Clerk.

Chair Kafoury asked the Board of Commissioners to introduce themselves after which she recognized the other Elected Officials in the audience.

Chair Kafoury said that this Public Hearing is not a time for the Board to deliberate, but for the Board to hear from the public on the programs within the Fiscal Year 2016 Budget. She said this public hearing is the third of three held pertaining to the budget. She said if attendees had not filled out a public testimony form yet, there was still time to do so and that the forms were in the back of the room.

Chair Kafoury advised that the Board Clerk will call up four individuals at a time to give testimony. When their name is called, they are to come up to the presenter's table, and when it is their turn to speak, they were to state their name for the record. Because of the large number signed up to testify, she limited testimony to two minutes per person. She also reminded the attendees that translation services were available in Russian, Spanish, Vietnamese and Somali/Swahili.

Testimony was taken and received for the file. Sixty-eight people signed up to testify on various programs through partner-agencies who provide services including: the new Courthouse, IRCO Programs, Cully Park, Lines for Life, Central City Concern, North Star, Luke-Dorf, Age-Friendly services, Unity Center Behavioral Health, el Programa Hispano, Justice Triage Funding, STRYVE Youth Violence Program, Health Nurse for Head Start, Homeless Families/Homes for Everyone, SUN Schools/SUN Pilot, Cascadia Behavioral Health, Westside Community Resource Officer funding, NAYA Family Center/Homeless Youth Continuum, and New Avenues Outreach for Youth. Written testimony was also received for the file.

Chair Kafoury invited others who had not signed up to testify, to do so. No one else did.

Chair Kafoury closed the public hearing, thanked everyone for coming, and adjourned the meeting at 8:25 p.m.
