

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

ORDINANCE NO. 218

An ordinance relating to eligibility to participate in the Sworn Law Officers' Retirement System; and amending Multnomah County Code Section 3.50.070(A)(3).

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. MCC 3.50.070 is amended to read:

(A) The retirement system shall be funded as follows:

(1) There shall be deducted from the gross salary of each member for each pay period an amount equal to seven percent of the member's basic salary, or an amount to be determined by a collective bargaining agreement, between the employee's union and Multnomah County as the employee's contribution to the fund.

(2) The employer shall contribute each pay period to the fund an amount equal to eight and eight-tenths percent of the basic salary for that pay period of each member as the employer's contribution to the fund, or an amount to be determined by a collective bargaining agreement between the employees' union and Multnomah County.

[(3) There shall be transferred to the fund the accumulated employee and employer contributions of any member who, immediately prior to becoming a member, was a member of the general county employees' retirement system. The transfer shall be made within 30 days of the date of eligibility for membership or November 30, 1974, whichever is later.]

(3) Provided an election is made under Subsection (A)(4) of MCC 3.50.070, there shall be transferred to the fund the accumulated employee contributions of any member who, immediately prior to becoming a member, was a member of the general county employees' retirement system.

(4) A member of the general county employees' retirement system made eligible to participate in this system who elects to pay into the retirement fund the difference between the transferred employee contribution and the amount which would have been contributed under MCC 3.50.070(A)(1) had the period of transferred county service covered by the general county employees' retirement system been served under this system shall be given credit for county service under MCC 3.50.180. This election shall be made within six (6) months of the date of eligibility for membership.


(B) Each month the employer shall transmit to the Retirement Board the contributions required in Paragraphs (1) and (2) of Subsection (A) of this section, together with a copy of the monthly payroll.

Adopted this 10th day of January, 1980, being the date of its second reading before the Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County, Oregon.


