Initiating the Vacation of a Portion of N.E. 242nd Connector, a County Road, and Directing the County Engineer to Prepare a Report to the Board

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. The portion of the N.E. 242nd Connector, County Road No. 5007, affected by this proposed vacation was established as a County Road by Order 95-111, on May 18th 1995 and recorded at No. 95-97067 in the Multnomah County Deed Records.
- b. The portion of N.E. 242nd Connector, County Road No. 5007, proposed to be vacated, is more particularly described as follows:

- c. The County Board by Resolution 2014-056, and through the execution of a certain Purchase and Sale Agreement approved under that Resolution, committed to the vacation of a certain portion of the NE 242nd Connector as more particularly described in Exhibit A, in a timely manner.
- d. In furtherance of the County's obligation to complete the vacation of the portion of the NE 242nd Connector, the County now begins the road vacation proceedings.
- e. To initiate the vacation, the Board must declare its intent to vacate and direct preparation of the road official's report in accordance with ORS 368.346.
- f. It is in the best public interest to initiate the vacation of the portion of the NE 242nd Connector described in Exhibit A.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:

1. Pursuant to ORS 368.341(2) this Board declares its intent to vacate the public right of way described in Exhibit A;
2. The County Engineer is directed to prepare and file a report with the Board in accordance with ORS 368.346(1); and

3. This matter shall be brought back before this Board on March 12, 2015; at such time the County Engineer or his designee, shall present the report to this Board.
