Thanks for taking my call earlier today and all your work with this new permitting / code process.

If there is any information regarding this that you think I would find helpful please pass it along.

Here is my letter in the hopes it helps your process:

To whom it may concern:

I recently purchased a 40 acre parcel of property zoned Forest Ag. There was an existing pole barn structure on the property which was permitted through an adjacent house several years ago. Since then the two lots were sold separately which voided the building permit. I haven't been able to work/build on my land due to this permit restriction.

I have my hands tied because I have no way of making this existing building legal without building a house on the land and I don't have any plans to build a house any time soon. I need a clear path to legally permit the structure and be able to work / build on my land and do so legitimately and in compliance with state and county codes. I want to do things right and I want the state and county to support people doing things correctly.

The new permanent forest land structure permits will be a great help in resolving the existing permit issues I have and gives me a clear and legal path towards future forest farm development. I can't thank the state and county enough for making this possible. I am sure I am one of many land owners that will benefit from these new permits

and codes.
