

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

FOR MULTNOMAH COUNTY, OREGON

ORDINANCE NO. 317

An ordinance establishing a sewer advisory committee in Multnomah County, to be known as the Citizens Advisory Committee on Financing Sewers in Unincorporated Urban Multnomah County, providing for appointment of committee members, and designating the purpose of the committee, and declaring an emergency.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

- A. The Board of County Commissioners finds that there is a need to initiate both short-term and long-range policies for financing sewer development and construction projects in the unsewered portions of the Unincorporated Urban Area of Multnomah County east of the Willamette River to:
1. Comply with the Environmental Quality Commission's directive to Multnomah County to:
 - a. Develop and implement a Master Plan for design and construction of sewerage facilities in the Inverness Basin;
 - b. Develop and implement a financial plan for provision of sewers in the Inverness Basin;
 - c. Cooperate with Gresham, Portland and Troutdale to develop and implement engineering and financial plans for serving the unsewered portions of Unincorporated Multnomah County outside the Inverness Basin and Central County Service District No. 3 geographic boundaries.

SECTION 3. COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED.

The Committee is hereby established and shall have the purpose described in this ordinance.

SECTION 4. MEMBERSHIP.

The Committee shall consist of seventeen (17) members who shall be, and remain during their terms, residents of Multnomah County, and shall serve without compensation except for reimbursement for duly authorized expenses.

SECTION 5. PURPOSE AND CHARGE.

A. The Committee shall:

1. Study Inverness Basin and all of sewer financing in the East County area, and shall submit recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners regarding the feasibility of financial and engineering plans developed for the County.
2. Study costs, financial projections and practicability of providing for sewer needs in the balance of Multnomah County, exclusive of the City of Portland; including Gresham, Troutdale, Unincorporated Urban Multnomah County, and the Inverness Basin.
3. Study options for providing urban services called for in the Comprehensive Plan of Multnomah County and the incorporated areas, exclusive of the City of Portland, as it relates to sewers.
4. Assist in developing legislation to promote favorable financing and development options for sewer construction and possible State and federal assistance.
5. Be authorized to carry on such other activities, suitable to an advisory committee, as may be incidental to or will assist in the accomplishment of the above purposes and the furtherance of the objectives set forth in Section 1.

- B. Reports and recommendations made by the committee shall be submitted to the County Executive and the Board of County Commissioners.

SECTION 6. COMMITTEE ACTIONS.

- A. The committee chairperson shall be appointed by the County Executive for the first year, and thereafter, the chairperson shall be elected by the members of the committee. A vice-chairperson shall be selected by the committee to serve in the chairperson's absence.
- B. The committee shall adopt rules of procedure or may conduct proceedings in accordance with Roberts Rules of Order, Revised, for the performance of its purpose, including formation of subcommittees, quorum and voting, filling of vacancies, and adoption of reports and recommendations.
- C. Meetings shall be held at least once monthly or as necessary to perform the functions of the committee.
- D. The committee shall exist for a period of a minimum of one year beginning June, 1982, and shall at the discretion of the County Executive and the Board of County Commissioners, continue for a period of one additional year without amendment of this ordinance, beginning June, 1983, and ending June, 1984.

SECTION 7. SAVINGS CLAUSE

In the event any subsection, subdivision, phrase, clause, sentence or word in this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not invalidate the remainder of this ordinance, but shall be confined to such subsection, subdivision, phrase, clause, sentence or word.

SECTION 8. EMERGENCY.


This ordinance being necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the people of Multnomah County, in order to provide sewer development financing and construction in Unincorporated Urban Area of East Multnomah County, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon the passage of the Board of County Commissioners and authentication by the County Executive.

ADOPTED this 10th day of June, 1982, being the date of its first reading before the Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County, Oregon.




