This case was brought by Disability Rights Oregon, alleging violation of civil rights and medical negligence toward a mentally ill inmate in a Multnomah County jail. The plaintiff was Tasered when he did not comply with the deputies' commands, and he did not receive treatment for his mental illness until he had been in custody for 48 hours. Settlement in this case is acceptable and avoids the expenses of a very lengthy and complex trial.


