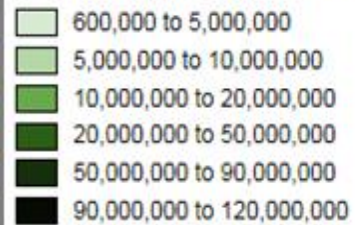


VETERAN FILES CLAIM THROUGH

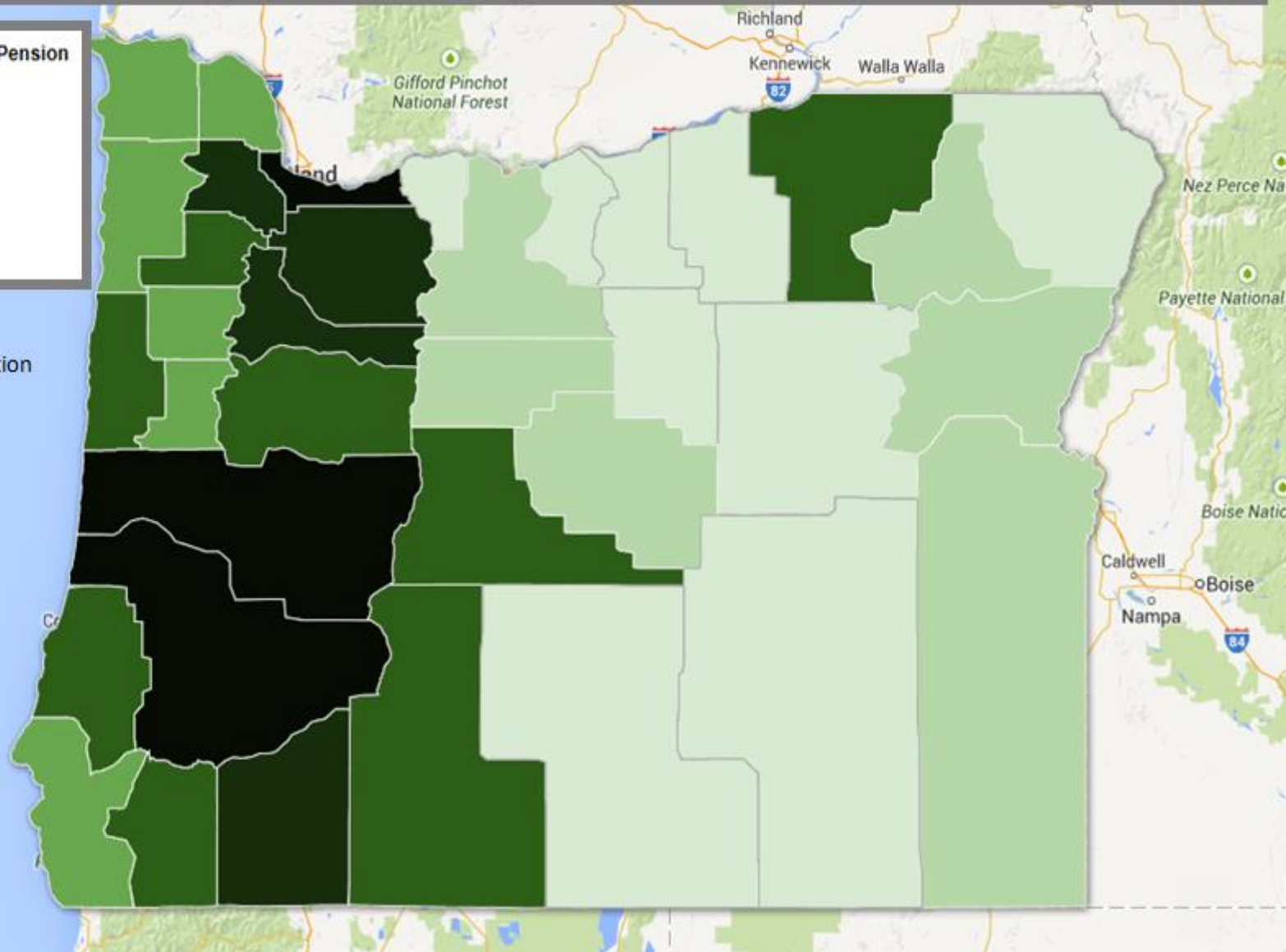

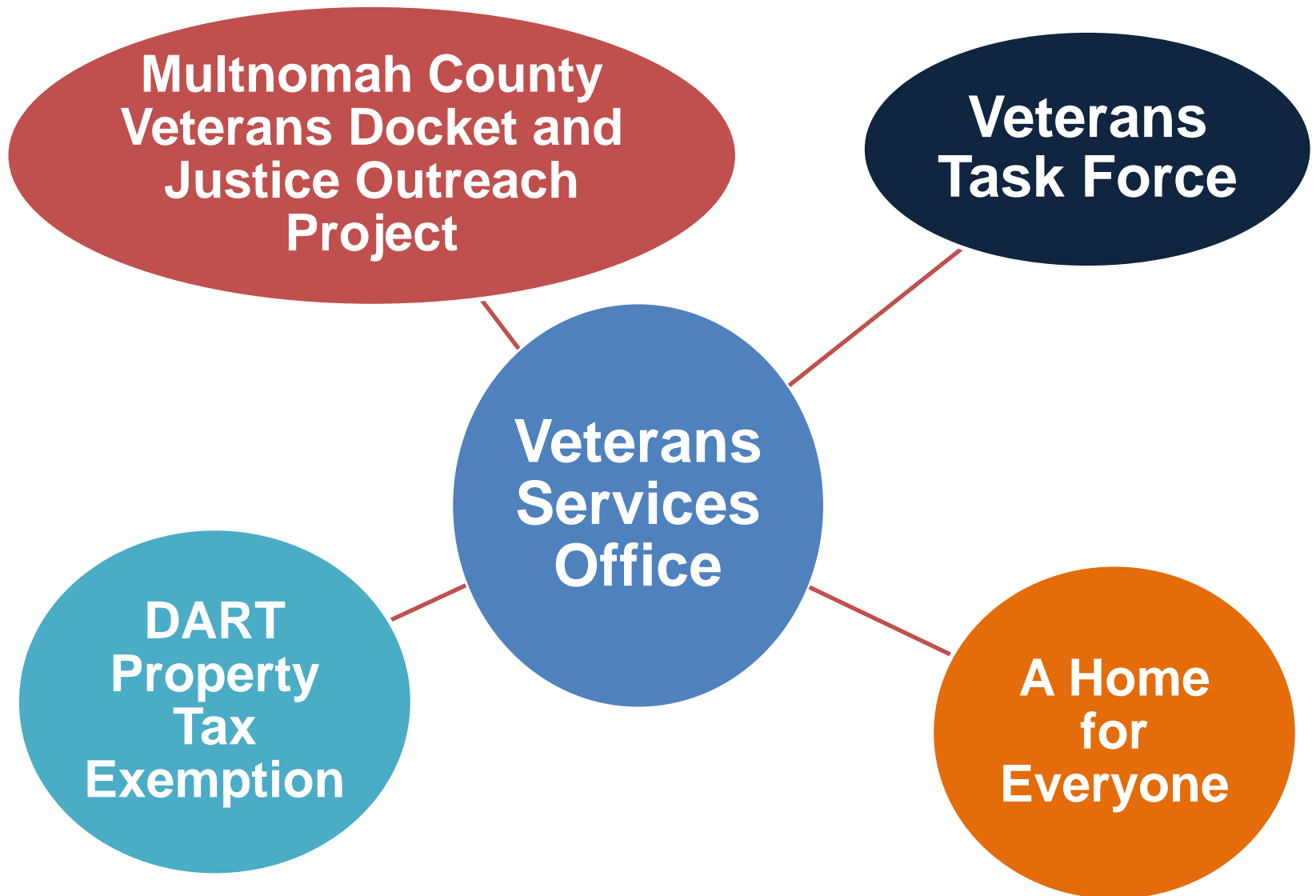

- Supported by Federal “25 Cities Initiative”
- Local collaborative stemming from United States Interagency Council on Homelessness (2010)



Home for Everyone Update

- Creation of a "Registry" of all homeless veterans
- Creating Preferences for Veterans at Home Forward and in our non-profit portfolios

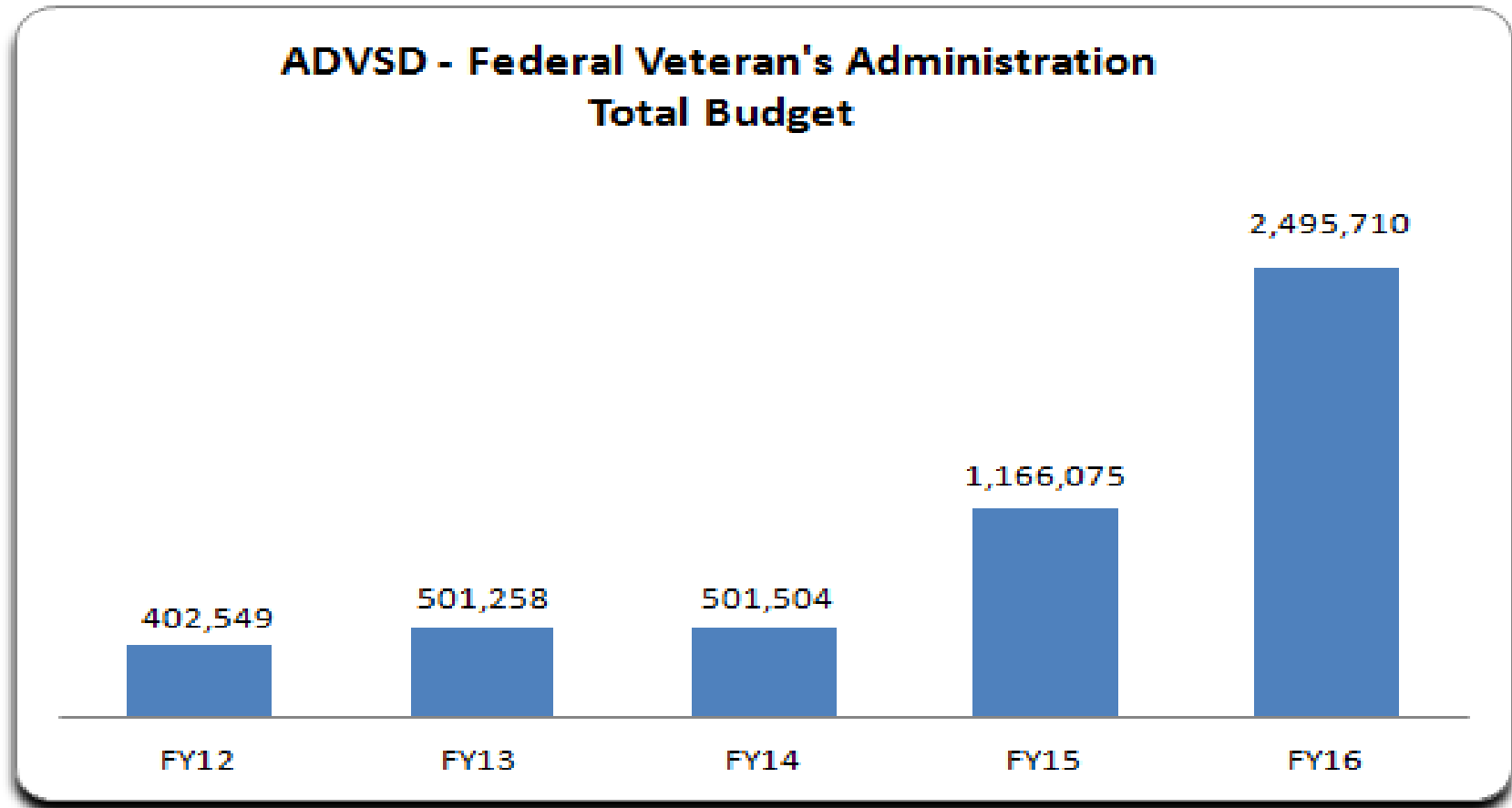

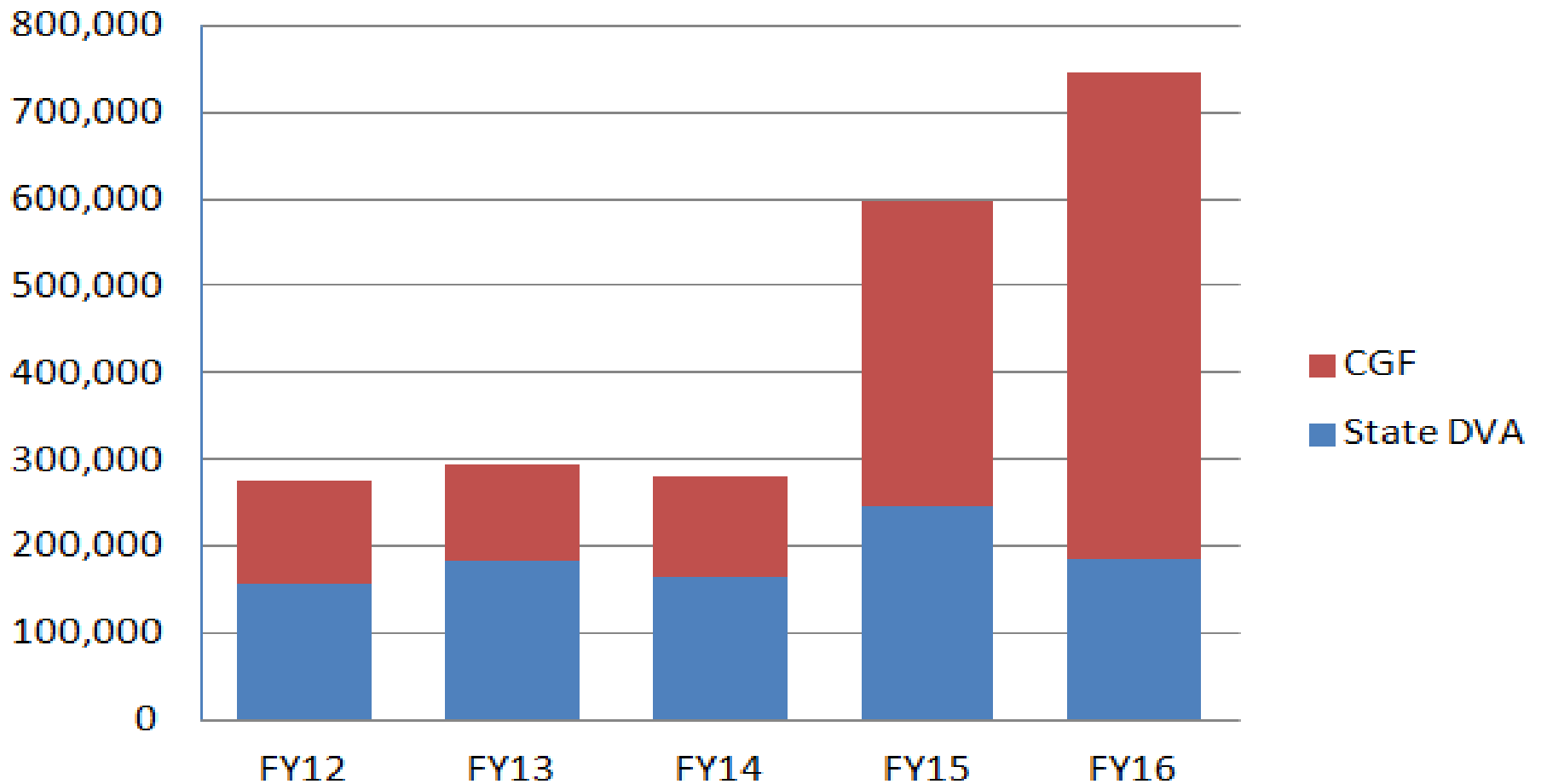


Helping veterans avoid nursing homes and remain at home
